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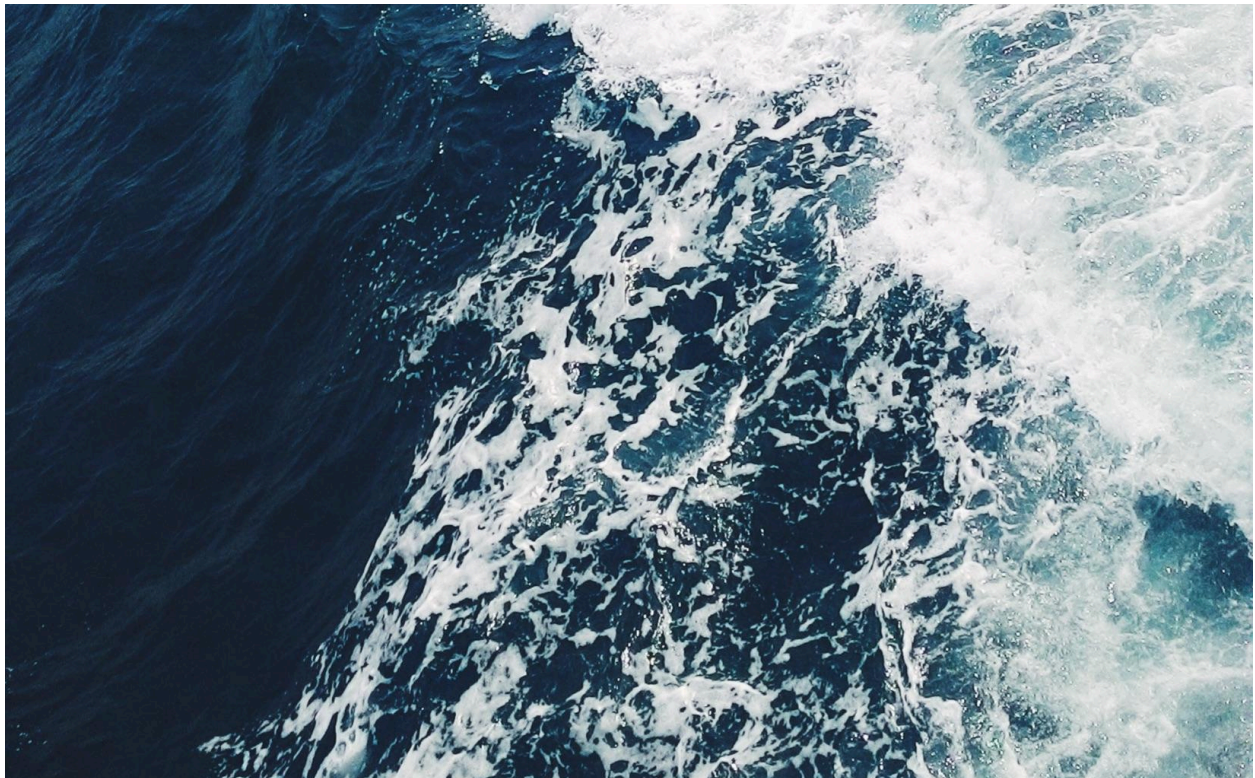

Calling of Spiritual Leader

Servants of God “Part 1 (Purpose of God’s servants)”

Day 1 (or Week 1: Calling I)

1. Prayer 15 min

- 1) Pray to know your calling from God.
 - 2) Pray that you can successfully finish the “Red Sea course”.
 - 3) Pray that more people would know their calling from God and obey Him.
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2. Read [Assigned readings](#) introductory part of page 4. (Download editable pdf on your laptop so you can type on the book digitally. You can download it on your smartphone or tablet as well but typing on it can be limited depending on which device you are using. Also read Jeremiah 1:5 and Galatians 1:15. Then answer the following questions.

1) What are the similarities between Jeremiah 1:5 and Galatians 1:15?

2) Is God’s calling in your life based on your skills and ability? If not, what ground does God call you? (Galatians 1:15)

3) Why is it important to be called by God?

3. Read Exodus 3:1-10 then answer the following questions.

1) Did God call Moses’ name first or did He call him for ministry first? What does that matter?

2) How did Moses meet God? And what was Moses’ calling from God?

4) How did you meet God? What was your experience to believe in God for the first time in your life?

5) If you have not met God yet, pray to God to meet you. To become a spiritual leader, one must become a born again follower of Jesus. Before moving to Day 2, read the following verses: Isaiah 55:6-7, John 1:12, John 3:16, Acts 2:38, Romans 10:9-10. And watch this video: <https://youtu.be/QTlev9zh2mU>

4. Assessments (Write in your journal):

- 1) What is the key point today?
 - 2) Compare Moses' story of meeting God and your story. What similarities or differences do you notice?
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Day 2 (or Week 2: Calling II)

1. Prayer 15 min

- 1) Pray to meet God in a powerful way.
 - 2) Pray that you will clearly discern calling from God in your life.
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2. Read [Assigned readings](#) page 5 and fill out questions 1-4 on "1. The purpose of God's servants" and watch [John 21:16](#) video. Then answer the following questions.

- 1) What kind of sin did Peter commit against Jesus?

- 2) How could a sinner like Peter serve God? What do you need to have to tend the flock of God?

3. Read Matthew 20:24-28

1) How are Christian leaders (servants of God) different from the worldly leaders?

2) How did Jesus show the example of servant leadership? (28v)

4. Assessments (Write in your journal)

1) What is the key point today?

2) Think of one thing you can serve others (your family, friends, neighbors, etc) and do it by next week.

Day 3 (or Week 3: Called to be the ambassador)

1. Prayer 15 min

1) Pray to know the connection between calling and the gospel.

2) Pray that more people would know their calling from God for the Great Commission.

2 Read [Assigned readings](#) page 5 and fill out questions 5-10 on “1. The purpose of God’s servants” then answer the following questions.

1) What is the primary task of God’s servants?

2) Why did God say “Paul would suffer”? (Acts 9:16) and how could Paul bear the suffering? (Philippians 3:8)

3) Are you also willing to suffer for the sake of Christ?

3. Watch [2 Corinthians 5:20](#) and answer the following questions.

1) What are two important identities you have in Christ? (2 Corinthians 5:17, 20):

2) Who is the ambassador of Christ?

3) Why is being the ambassador of Christ more than a job?

4) What is the message we speak as the ambassador of Christ?

5) Memorize 2 Corinthians 5:20.

2) Write about your role as an ambassador for Christ. (e.g. sharing the gospel, living Christ-like life, etc.)

Day 4 (or Week 4: Called to build the church)

2. Read [Assigned readings](#) page 6, fill out questions 11-16 and answer questions below.

1) What is the primary responsibility of church leaders? (Ephesians 4:12)

2) Why is it important to use the Bible in equipping people in the church? (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

3) What is the primary source for the leaders to serve in the church? (1 Peter 4:11)

3. Watch [Ephesians 4:12](#) and answer the following questions.

1) What is the purpose of equipping the saints?

2) How do you connect Matthew 16:18 and Ephesians 4:12?

3) Memorize Ephesians 4:12

4. Assessments

1. What are the key points?

2. Write about how you can help build a church. (e.g. greeting new comers, helping children/youth ministry, teaching, community outreach, etc.)

Day 5 (or Week 5: Calling for ministry)

2) Pray that you would be obedient to His calling at your church.

2. Read and meditate on Ephesians 4:11-16 and answer the following questions:

5) Which one is more important? Position or purpose? And why?

3. Review memory verses for this week (2 Corinthians 5:20, Ephesians 4:12) and answer the following questions.

1) What is your main calling as an ambassador for Christ? (2 Corinthians 5:20)

2) What do you need to do for other believers? (Ephesians 4:12)

4. Project

1) Take 10-15 minutes to review what you have learned so far and ask the Lord what your calling from Him is.

2) Share your calling from God with others in your group.
