- ➢ An A4 notebook/pad/paper


Things to write about are like this.

Additional notes are in black.

These are short writing exercises. Some silly, some crazy, some serious.

For Short exercises, try to write about 3 lines of A4. For Medium, about half the page. For Long, a whole page.

You can do them in any order, but I recommend them in this order as some of them are themed together. This is meant to be fun, don't put too much thought in!



Medium- Write a letter from your friend to their boss as to why they don't deserve the raise

Medium- Remember the longest round of applause you've ever heard. What would get a longer one and why?

Long- Write a review of the worst place you've ever visited or stayed. Give it a 5-star review, turning all the negatives into good things for someone.

Perhaps the tiny bed would be ideal for a toddler or the noisy nightclub next door would be great for a raver.

Short- 5 things you love about:

- The autumn
- Vegetarian cooking
- Pornographic websites
- Past American presidents
- Clickbait
- Your bed
- Dragons

Long- Imagine a meeting between your favourite book character and their author. What would they say to each other?

Short- What's the best cure for stupidity?

Short- What's the best cure for insomnia?

Medium- Dear Mum, I'm sorry I broke all your windows but...

Medium- What government committee doesn't exist but really should?

Short- Which TV programme should be cancelled forever and why?

Short- Which TV programme should be brought back and never cancelled again?

Short- The Easter Bunny has been quarantined! Describe his replacement

Short- Congratulations! You've been promoted to God! Who are the first 3 people you smite?



Short- A really bad sandwich filling is...

Long- Who is this? Write their backstory.

Short- When you wish upon a star, what actually happens?

Short- Pinocchio's nose grows when he lies but when his ears get bigger, that means...

Short- For this, you'll need a power drill and a BIG cup of coffee.
