




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
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PARTS DIAGRAM





WARNING: To reduce the risk of death, serious injury, or property damage, read and follow this safety information and the provided instructions when assembling this product. Do not change or replace components and accessories.

INSTALL ONLY APPROVED WORK SURFACES

This table system does not include a work surface (desktop). Maximum load for table is 200 lb, including work surface. Desktop dimensions for X-Base are not to exceed 24" (square) or 30" (round). Maximum desktop depth for C- and T-Leg not to exceed 30". If you are unsure if your preferred work surface meets specifications, contact customer service.

DO NOT OVERLOAD DESK

To prevent table from tipping or collapsing, make sure the desk frame is not overloaded by the weight of tabletop and objects on table. Evenly distribute load; excess loads near edges can reduce stability and cause table to tip over.

- Do not exceed maximum load (including weight of desktop) of 200 lb (91Kg)
- Do not exceed edge load of 25 lb when positioning monitors or mounting accessories
- · Do not sit or stand on table

USE CARE WHEN MOVING TABLE

- · Remove all objects and mounted accessories from the table before moving
- · Clear objects and equipment from table before rolling to reduce the risk of tipping over

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the table frame to be made in accordance with this manual.

Changes to the table frame or improper use may affect the safety, function, and life of your product.

This manual applies to the following table bases: 24"/30" T-Leg, 24"/30" C-Leg, 30" X-Base, Flip Top

ASSEMBLY OVERVIEW

FIXED BASES (page 8-9)

- 1. Assemble the foot to the column
- 2. Attach the column to the table top

FLIP TOP BASE (page 10-14)

- 1. Assemble the foot to the column
- 2. Attach column assemblies to the support rail
- 3. Attach top supports to the support rail
- 4. Install plastic spacer
- 5. Mount the assembled flip base to table top
- 6. Install collission bumpers and mount paddle to table top
- 7. Level table and tighten axle screws
- 8. Install wire clips and adjust the cable tension
- 9. Install paddle cover



ASSEMBLE THE FOOT TO THE COLUMN

Install four (4) M6 button head screws through the bottom of the foot and into the threaded holes in the bottom of the column.

X-Base: Be sure to attach mending plate on bottom with accompanying screws.

NOTE: Do not drive the screws into the column with a drill or impact driver without first starting the screws by hand.






ATTACH COLUMN TO THE TABLE TOP


Use the chart below to locate the position of the pilot holes on the table top.

X-Base on a square work surface must be mounted with feet in line with the corners of the work surface, as shown. Failure to follow this step will result in poor stability.

LEG CONFIGURATION	FRONT CORNER HOLE DEPTH LOCATION (X)	FRONT CORNER HOLE WIDTH LOCATION (Y)
24 in T-Leg	1.5 in	2.5 in
30 in T-Leg	1.5 in	2.5 in
24 in C-Leg	1.5 in	6.25 in
30 in C-Leg	1.5 in	7.25 in






Mark the locations of the pilot holes. Drill the pilot holes to the size recommended by the table top manufacturer. Install the screws through the mounting plate into the table top.

NOTE: The holes in the mounting plate are .280" in diameter.





1 ASSEMBLE THE FOOT TO THE COLUMN
Install four (4) M6 button head screws through the bottom of the foot and into the threaded holes in the bottom of the column.

NOTE: Do not drive the screws into the column with a drill or impact driver without first starting the screws by hand.

2 ATTACH COLUMN ASSEMBLIES TO THE SUPPORT RAIL










ATTACH TOP SUPPORTS TO THE SUPPORT RAIL Refer to Illustrations C and D.

















LEVEL TABLE AND TIGHTEN AXLE SCREWS

Carefully turn the table into the upright position with top in the flat position, then apply light downward pressure on the outside centers of table. This will ensure that the top support is sitting flat on the support rail. Tighten each M6 axle screw on both sides of the table (maximum torque is 10 Nm or 88 in-lbs).




INSTALL WIRE CLIPS AND ADJUST THE CABLE TENSION

Carefully turn the table upright and depress the release paddle.

Adjust the tension by turning the collar of the cable at the paddle counter-clockwise until the cable is loose, but still connected. Turn clockwise until a slight resistance is felt. Repeat for the opposite side.

Lower table top to flat position and press the release paddle to test. If table does not release, turn collar another quarter turn clockwise. Repeat until table releases.
