## Barn Rules and Safety

Your safety and that of our riders, staff, and horses is our primary concern. Please follow the rules listed below so we can provide a safe environment for everyone.

- 1. No abusive, threatening, loud or violent behavior will be tolerated on the premises.
- 2. Alcohol and illegal drug use is prohibited.
- 3. Absolutely no smoking or use of open flame is permitted on the premises.
- 4. No one is permitted at the barn or on the grounds unless a staff member is present or on the premises. Prior permission must be received from the instructor or equine manager.
- 5. Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- 6. No running or screaming is allowed in the barn or around the horses
- 7. No one is allowed to handle the horses, feed, or pet horses unless supervised by a staff member. No one may enter a stall or paddock containing horses unless accompanied by a staff member, except for volunteers when on a specific task. Close every door/gate you open.
- 8. No one may ride a horse unless supervised by a staff member. Everyone who rides must have a current and complete Registration/Release Packet on file with Bluff & Ridge Equine Assisted Therapies, Inc.
- 9. Participants must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet when riding or working with horses.
- 10.All volunteers must have a completed, signed and dated Volunteer Packet on file in order to work at Bluff & Ridge Equine Assisted Therapies. All volunteers must complete a volunteer training. Volunteers must sign--in and sign--out whenever they are on premise.
- 11.Instructors will routinely check all tack and equipment for safety.
- 12. Barn aisles must be kept clean and free of hazardous obstructions.
- 13.No visiting dogs are allowed on property.
- 14. Report all incidents and hazardous conditions to a staff member as soon as possible.
- 15. Ask questions if you don't know the answer.
