5-day Bible devotional guide -Bless This Home-Purity

Day 1: The Christ-Centered Home

Reading: Galatians 2:20

Challenge your family to be intentional about filling your home with things that honor God. Pray for wisdom in making choices that will build up your family's faith and character.

Day 5: Building a Home of Faith

Reading: Joshua 24:15

Devotional: Joshua's declaration, "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord," is a powerful commitment to making faith central in the home. Reflect on how you can make this your family's declaration. Discuss practical ways to put God at the center of your daily life, such as regular family devotions, praying together, or serving others as a family. Consider creating a family mission statement that reflects your commitment to serving God. Pray for God's guidance in leading your family in faith and for the strength to stand firm in this commitment.
