

## **Hebrews 6- Week Three -Five Day Devotional**

### **Day 1: Persevering in Faith**

Reading: Hebrews 10:19-25

Devotional: As we reflect on the importance of perseverance in our faith, let's consider how easy it can be to fall into religious routine without experiencing true spiritual transformation. The writer of Hebrews encourages us to "hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering" (v. 23). Today, examine your heart. Are you simply going through the motions of Christianity, or are you actively pursuing a deepening relationship with Christ? Remember, genuine faith produces visible fruit in our lives. Ask God to reveal areas where you may have become complacent, and commit to taking intentional steps towards spiritual growth.

### **Day 2: The Power of the Resurrection**

Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:12-22

Devotional: The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the cornerstone of our faith. It confirms that our belief is not in vain, our victory is assured, and sin's power over us is broken. As you read today's passage, meditate on the profound implications of Christ's resurrection in your daily life. How does the reality of the resurrection impact your decisions, your outlook on challenges, and your interactions with others? Let the truth that you serve a living Savior empower you to live boldly for Him today, knowing that the same power that raised Christ from the dead is at work within you.

### **Day 3: Living in Light of Eternal Judgment**

Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:6-10

Devotional: The concept of eternal judgment can be sobering, but for believers, it serves as a powerful motivator to live purposefully for Christ. Today's passage reminds us that we will all appear before the judgment seat of Christ to give an account for our lives. Reflect on

how you're using the grace God has given you. Are you building His kingdom or pursuing your own interests? Remember, every day is an opportunity to invest in eternity. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in making choices that will bear fruit for God's glory, knowing that your faithfulness will be rewarded in eternity.

#### Day 4: The Transforming Power of God's Grace

Reading: Titus 2:11-14

Devotional: God's grace is not just about forgiveness; it's a transformative power that enables us to live godly lives. As you read today's passage, consider how God's grace has changed you. Have you allowed it to teach you to say "no" to ungodliness and worldly passions? Reflect on areas where you've seen growth and areas where you still struggle. Thank God for His ongoing work in your life, and ask Him to continue molding you into the image of Christ. Remember, true salvation always leads to a changed life – not perfection, but a consistent pursuit of holiness.

#### Day 5: Assurance of Salvation

Reading: 1 John 5:11-13

Devotional: The assurance of our salvation is a precious gift that brings peace and confidence to our faith journey. Today's reading emphasizes that those who have the Son have life. Reflect on the evidence of Christ's presence in your life. Do you see the fruit of the Spirit growing? Is there a desire to know God more and to live for His glory? While our salvation is not based on our works, a transformed life is evidence of genuine faith. Thank God for the assurance He provides through His Word and the internal witness of the Holy Spirit. Let this assurance motivate you to live boldly for Christ, sharing His love with others who need the hope of salvation.
