

Life Changing Prayers "Beauty from Ashes: The Power of Healing Prayer": Outline

- God Sees, God Saves (Psalm 34:15-19)
 - Main Point: God draws near to the broken
 - Application:
 - Pain is not proof of God's absence
 - The Lord runs to our brokenness
 - God hears and moves when we cry out
 - Encouragement:
 - Bring your pain to God in prayer

- Affliction Has a Purpose (2 Corinthians 4:17-18)
 - Main Point: Pain is the process, not the end
 - Illustration: Potter refining clay
 - Encouragement:
 - Let God finish the work
 - Pain may be building glory
 - Prayer Focus: Use pain to shape for God's glory

- Beauty for Ashes (Isaiah 61:1-3)
 - Main Point: Healing often comes after the fire
 - Key Insight: Ashes come from consumption
 - Spiritual Principle: God transforms what we surrender
 - Praise Key:
 - Choosing praise reverses failing spirit
 - Praising in pain releases strength

- He Heals the Broken (Psalm 147:1-7)
 - Main Point: God is a hands-on healer
 - Encouragement:
 - Not beyond repair
 - God stitches hearts together
 - Praise Response: Worship as a healing weapon

- The Prayer of Faith Heals (James 5:13-16)
 - Main Point: Healing flows through faith-filled prayer
 - Types of Healing:
 - Physical Pain
 - Emotional Trauma
 - Mental Fatigue
 - Spiritual Weakness
 - Key Encouragement: Praying for true healing in every area
 - Call to Action:
 - Pray with others
 - Confess, unite, and believe together
