The Cleveland Roller Mill Museum

Cleveland, NM • guided tours • clevelandrollermillmuseum.org (575) 387-3645

Built in 1900 -1901 by Joseph Fuss and operated by him until 1913. It was purchased By Daniel Cassidy Sr. and the Cassidy family operated the mill it until the 1940's. It was restored in 1980's to operating condition for demonstration purposes and operating on both days. Enjoy music - food - arts & crafts - guided tours - special speakers.

La Cueva Mill / Houser Raspberry Ranch

La Cueva, NM • Free Admission • houser-rr.com (575) 387-6964

Originally founded in 1851 as part of the Mora Land Grant, La Cueva Mill is a storied Santa Fe Trail landmark recently reopened under new stewardship. Phil and Theresa

Houser are actively restoring the historic gristmill while operating the property as a vibrant community space. Dine at the La Cueva Café and explore 90 acres of farmland
Trolley tours depart from here.

The St. Vrain Mill (El Molino de Piedra)

Mora, NM • Free Admission • stvrainmill.org (505) 795- 2233

Built in 1864 - the oldest mill on the tour. Ceran St. Vrain's flour mill was a critical supplier to Fort Union and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. A landmark achievement for the Saint Vrain Mill Preservation and Historical Foundation: the historic stone wall stabilization project is now complete. Restoration continues with the long-term vision of establishing a Mora County Heritage Center. Food available.

** The Las Vegas No. 11 Trolley - FREE Hourly Round Trips**

Ride free on the historic Las Vegas No. 11 Trolley for a narrated journey through the Mora Valley, stopping at all three mills. Hourly departures from La Cueva Mill beginning at 10:00 AM. No ticket required - just show up and climb aboard!
