Step 1: You Sort

Your part is easy! Just sort and prep your photos before sending them to us. Here's a checklist to guide you

- [] **Remove photos from albums:** Gently take each photo out of its album, scrapbook, or frame. Be careful not to tear or bend them.
- [] **Dust them off:** Use a soft, dry cloth to gently wipe away any dust or debris from the surface of each photo. Avoid using liquids.
- [] **Group photos:** Sort your photos into groups
- [] Label your groups: Group 1, Group 2 etc. If you want the folders naming include details

Step 2: We Scan

Once we receive your prepared photos, we will carefully scan each one using professional-grade equipment. Here's what you can expect:

We Can Scan:

- Loose photos (all sizes)
- Photos with writing on the back
- Black and white photos
- Color photos
- Polaroids

We Cannot Scan:

- Photos still in albums or frames
- Photos stuck to glass or other surfaces
- Negatives or slides (available as seperate service)
- Anything larger than 8x10 inches

Step 3: You Share

After scanning, we'll return everything to you, plus a little extra to share with family and friends:

- Your original photos, carefully packaged
- A USB drive with high-resolution digital images of all your photos sorted into groups
