Here at Tigger's Wigglers, we use wood chips, green grass and food scraps to create a highly nutritious compost through a process known as thermophilic composting.

We then take that compost and feed it to millions of red wiggler worms inside our Michigan soil works reactors. The red wigglers digest the compost and break it down into simpler forms that are easy for plants and trees to use. The worms also super charge the compost with enzymes and beneficial bacteria that promote overall soil quality and health.

The excretion of a worm is called "vermicast" or "castings". The reason we call them "Magick Castings" is self-evident. Just add Tigger's Wigglers Magick castings to your garden and see for yourself!
