Role and Responsibilities

- Assist VP of Community Support to develop and implement 988 staffing and training plans.
- Supervise, support, mentor, and coach staff to meet 988 standards.
- Identify, enhance, and oversee training opportunities to advance 988 staff development.
- Supervise and provide guidance on difficult calls or when emergency rescues are needed.
- Ensure 988 documentation is accurate and complete.
- Submit reports as requested.
- Communicate outages or sudden spikes in call, chat, and /or text volumes to State and National Crisis Services Supervisors as required and other leadership as appropriate.
- Assist in troubleshooting infrastructure issues.
- Support 988 workforce by filling in when needed.
- Remain flexible to support other shifts based on business needs.
- Use independent judgment and make decisions with organizational consequences.
- Active rescue responsibility may be carried out by team lead requiring more experience, greater responsibility, and higher consequences to organization.
- Supervise and regularly coach and support 988 team members.
- Other duties as assigned.

- 4+ years of related work experience in mental health counseling or mental health crisis strongly preferred.
