

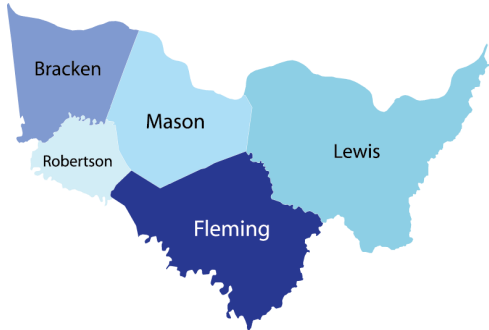

Delivering mental health services to young children is one of the many crucial community services provided by Comprehend, Inc. Statistics show that early childhood mental health intervention is vital:

- Young children with challenging behavior are less likely to be successful in kindergarten and more likely to be rejected by their peers.
- Early appearing aggressive behaviors are the best predictor of juvenile gang membership and violence.
- When aggressive and anti-social behavior persists to age 9, further intervention has a poor chance of success.

Each year, hundreds of families in our community, from every walk of life, seek the extra help children often need at an early age to enhance success in early learning, improving social skills, and reducing behavior challenges.
