Requirements and Benefits

Our sober living environment is safe and structured for people in recovery with these requirements for residency.



- Attend AA/NA meetings
- Abide by curfew
- Attend house meetings
- Keep personal area clean—Do daily chores
- Be considerate and respectful to other guests
- Follow house rules of the Harmony House
- Submit to random drug/alcohol testing
- Pay rent on time
- You may have a car
- You may work any shift; exceptions are made to curfew times if a conflict with work schedule
- Cell phones, laptops and registered vehicles in good working order are allowed
- Adhere to a daily schedule

Unfortunately, Harmony House is not large enough to accommodate residents who have minor children. Minor children will be allowed to visit residents during regular visiting hours.
