Role and Responsibilities

Provide direct clinical services for caseload of assigned clients primarily composed of *individuals affiliated* with the KSTEP program.

Completion of administrative paperwork, treatment plans, notes, etc., for medical records in a timely manner as required.

Participate in KSTEP family team meetings and other KSTEP meetings as required and indicated.

Maintain all requirements for licensure or eligibility per the state licensing board including participation and documentation of clinical supervision

Meet all requirements for agency required trainings annually or as required including electronic health records.

Assist KSTEP Coordinator in meeting KSTEP program requirements.

Other duties as assigned including serving on call as part of on call pool for the agency.

Qualifications and Education Requirements

Master's degree in social work, psychology, counseling or similar behavioral health degree. Licensed or license eligible to be a KY SUD provider.

Special/Physical Requirements

Capability of responding in the community in locales which may not be handicapped accessible.

Willing and able to travel inside and outside of the region.

Must possess a valid driver's license.

Occasional requirement to provide assessment/intervention services and/or consultation outside of normal business hours including serving on call as part of agency clinical on call pool.
