What is a High-Risk Pregnancy?

A high-risk pregnancy could be caused by one or more of the following risk factors:

- Poor nutrition
- Domestic violence
- Tobacco use
- Alcohol use
- Drug use
- Stress
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Family issues
- · Little or no prenatal care

These risk factors may lead to problems such as:

- Intellectual/Developmental delays
- Impaired growth
- Facial malformations
- Organ defects
- Premature birth
- Low birth weight
- Eating and sleeping problems
- Placental abruption
- Excessive crying
- Poor sucking ability
- · Learning disabilities
- Withdrawal from substances used during pregnancy
