

Core Principles

- 1. All people have the capacity to learn and grow
- 2. All people are to be treated with respect, dignity, and with a conscious and consistent effort to eliminate discrimination of any type, including discrimination based on disabling conditions.
- 3. Services are to be designed to address the unique needs of each individual.
- 4. Services encourage and support the involvement of the person in community activities.
- 5. The involvement of persons receiving services and their family members is essential to the effective operation and evaluation of the Life Connections Program.
