## Estimated Cost Breakdown* as of 1/2024

The overall cost of obtaining a private pilot certificate will vary from person to person mainly because a student pilot can only obtain a certificate upon demonstrating their complete proficiency in the operation of an aircraft and everyone's learning is different. The following breakdown is based on the average student pilot who flies one to two times per week and acquires their certificate in 55 hours.
