SGT. CARROLL'S FUNERAL TODAY

Services at Waco Baptist Church for Soldier Killed in Germany.

CHERRYVILLE, Aug 21, - Final rites for Sgt. Joyce Brewer Carroll, who was killed in a bombing mission over Germany April 11, 1944, will be held Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at Waco Baptist church. Rev. A. M. Kiser will conduct the services. Interment will be in Capuinam cemetery.

Sergeant Brewer attended Waco High School and was a member of Waco Baptist church. He enlisted in the Army in May 1940, and was sent to Panama, where he served for 18 months. He returned to the states and received additional training before being sent to the European theater of war in December 1943.

Survivors are his mother, Mrs. Gadie B. Carroll of Waco, his father, W. B. Carroll of Siler City; two sisters, Miss Beam Carroll of the home and Mrs. Hugh Davis of Cherryville.
