What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help the site function correctly, remember your preferences, and collect information about how visitors use the site.

Categories of Cookies We Use

- **Essential cookies:** strictly necessary for the website to operate. These cannot be disabled and do not require consent.
- **Analytics cookies:** help us understand aggregate visitor behaviour and improve site performance. These require consent and can be disabled without affecting core site functionality.
- **Preference cookies:** would remember your settings and choices (e.g., language, display preferences). ForenSights does not currently use preference cookies. If this changes, this policy will be updated accordingly.
- **Third-party cookies:** set by service providers other than ForenSights to deliver embedded functionality, such as bot detection. Data collected through these cookies is subject to the relevant third party's own privacy practices.

These cookies are required for the website to function. They cannot be disabled. No personal data is collected beyond what is technically necessary.

Analytics Cookies

We use Google Analytics to understand general visitor behaviour on our website. Google processes this data in accordance with its own privacy policy at [google.com/policies/privacy](https://policies.google.com/privacy). ForenSights does not use this data to identify individual visitors.

Third-Party Cookies

We use Google reCAPTCHA on our contact and enquiry forms to detect and prevent bot submissions and fraud. This service may process visitor interaction data in accordance with Google's own privacy policy at google.com/policies/privacy. We do not control, and are not responsible for, the data practices of third-party providers beyond our contractual arrangements with them.
