On this webpage, The Morris Land documents was found under the "Businesses" Tab. This Tab also covered Morris Family Churches, Businesses, solicitations, etc.

Evangelo "Vann" Morris Maintained two websites in 2009, 1ufa.com and Joanrita.com. He paid for both websites. The website here is 1ufa.com that is known as "Morris". 1ufa.com was designed to slowly phase out Joanrita.com since Joanrita.com was not able to provide web-enabled databasing, which was a feature that Vann wanted to family to have.

Eventually, 1ufa.com would also be phased out and replaced by Evangelomorris.com mainly because the web host / provider did not have adequate support for Tablet & Mobile ready webpages.

3 - 5 PM, check into the [Sailport Waterfront Suites](#) located at 2506 North Rocky Point Drive, Tampa, FL 33607.

All rooms have a waterfront view, full kitchen including dishes/pots/pans, one private bed room (queen size) and one pullout sofa (queen size) in the family room. Fishing is Authorized at the Hotel, so bring a fishing pole and bait.

At 6:45PM, we will walk to the [Rusty Pelican Restaurant](#) (Ph: 813-281-1943) for dinner, located next door to your Hotel. Menu choices are poultry, beef, fish, and veggie entrees. Dress code is business casual (pants and polo shirt equivalent). Average meal price is \$19.

Please treat your family to this dinner, because "You Deserve it." During this dinner, you will fellowship with everyone, Vann & Rita will welcome you and discuss the plans.

Day 2 (Tuesday 25 JUN):

Everyone will depart the Hotel at 11AM to arrive at [Clearwater Beach](#) at 11:30AM. Lunch will be catered on the Beach at 1200 Noon.

Lunch menu is Turkey, Ham, and veggie wraps, cookies, chips, fruit, Snapple / Lipton drinks and bottled water.

This white sand beach is Tampa's Main Attraction. Things to do: Relax, play frisbee, beach volleyball, [Jet Skis](#), para-sailing, and more.

Option 1: At 4PM, go to the Clearwater [Grand Prix Go Karts](#). These are Serious European style 45MPH go Karts. Luke (858-869-7691) is the Coordinator for the Go Karts event.

After racing, go to dinner at [Crabby Bills Restaurant](#) located at 7700 W. Courtney Campbell Cswy, Tampa, FL 33607. Located less than 1 mile from our hotel. Yes, they serve more than seafood. Dress Code is very casual (shorts / T-shirts).

Average cost per meal: \$14. The restaurant has a tropical atmosphere good for vacationers. Sand volleyball, sack toss, and horse shoes can be played on the grounds. 6:30PM dinner.

Option 2: At 5PM, depart Clearwater. Go back to the hotel to get cleanded up for a relaxing dinner at [Crabby Bills](#) 6:30PM.

Day 3 (Wednesday 26 JUN):

Option 1: At 8:30AM, depart for Orlando to attend either [Universal Studios](#), The [Holy Land](#), or [Disney](#). Luke (858-869-7691) is the Coordinator for Option 1. All theme parks at Orlando are very thrilling and full of adventure. This is an All-Day event in Orlando.

Depart Tampa at 8PM for a 9:15 arrival at the Hotel. You will be on your own for dinner. We have several good "Tampa Local" restaurants that you may like to eat at.

Option 2: At 10:30AM, depart for [Siesta Key Beach](#). Vann Sr (831-869-1882) is the Coordinator for Option 2. The journey is nearly 1 hour from the Hotel. Siesta Key is the most beautiful beach in Tampa.

Its white beach are made of quartz (not sand) and the water is clearest of them all. We will grab lunch at local hut or just go to Subway. At 3PM we will go back to Tampa.

COLLEGE PREPARATION

CAPPEX:

Once you create a profile on the CAPPEX website, you are then able to determine which colleges will more than likely admit you. You will also be able to apply for scholarships. Lastly, the CAPPEX website will allow you to learn the criteria for any college that you are interested in.

College Board:

Find out when and where you can take the next SAT nearest you. The College Board is driven by a single goal — to ensure that every student has the opportunity to prepare for, enroll in and graduate from college.

Government Grants:

Yearly, there are over 1,000 Federal Programs, 24,000 State Programs, 30,000 Private Foundations and 20,000 Scholarship Programs available. This website digs into Minority grants, personal grants, business grants, women's grants, and so on.

Financial Aid:

Learn the critical parts in preparing for college. Learn the different types of Aid and who gets Aid. This website includes information for middle school, high school, and adults wanting to go back to college and finish what they started.

College SOUP:

This website digs deep into private student loans, deferments, forbearances, consolidation programs, repayments, for graduate and undergraduates.

The Gold Standard Mindset



Upon completion of 12 years of grade school, your hard work will be summarized in two numbers: Your GPA and SAT scores.

Having strong GPA and SAT scores are better than having Gold.

While in K - 12 grade, your full time job is to get good grades. Otherwise, you are not doing your JOB. Commit to the following Gold Standard mindset:

A = Above Average
B = Average
C = Below Average
D & F = Absolute Failure

Morris Family youth, are your SAT scores good enough?

SAT scores can make or break an application. Also, schools usually make their SAT data public, and they know that their reputations depend upon high numbers. A college won't be considered "highly selective" or "elite" if its students have an average SAT math score of 470.

So what is a good SAT score? The exam consists of three parts: Critical Reading, Mathematics and Writing, with ranges from 200 to 800 in each section. Best possible total score is 2400. The average score for each section is roughly 500, so the average total score is about 1500. For the 1.65 million test-takers in the class of 2011, the mean scores were 497 critical reading, 514 math, and 489 reading.

Finally, you'll see that some of the school profiles include the critical reading and math scores, but not the writing scores. This is because the writing part of the exam is still new, and many schools do not yet use it in their admissions decisions. We're likely to see that change in the next couple years as colleges figure out the relationship between the writing score and academic success.

If you have an above average GPA and score above a 1500 on the SAT, then you will find large scholarships and grants much easier to obtain. Your Faith and Work will determine your financial college awards.

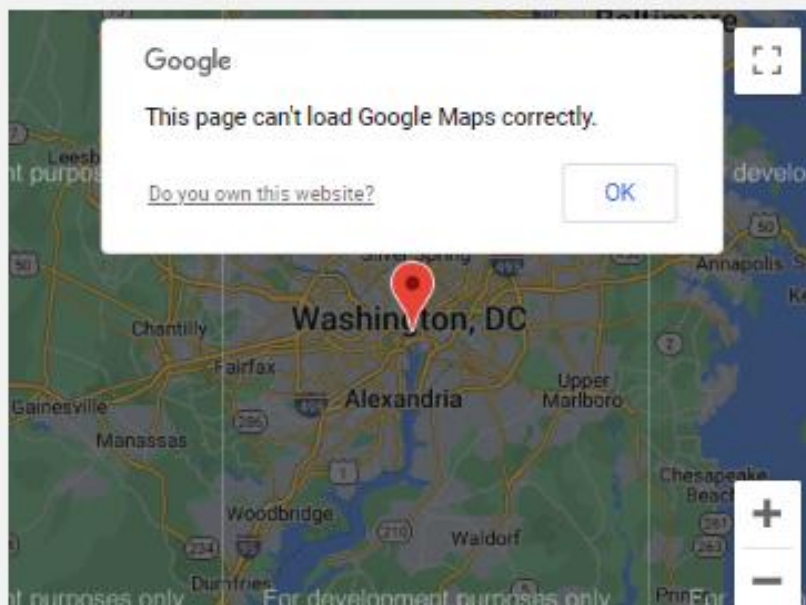
