NOON-TIME CONCERT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Noon-Time Concert features teacher performances, with selections of music less than 10 minutes. The recital space will have a Steinway grand piano for works to be performed. All individuals will pay a **submission fee*** in addition to the conference registration fee.

Submission Requirements

- Repertoire Accepted
 - Solo Classical Piano Repertoire, from Baroque to the 21st century
 - 4-Hand Piano Repertoire, from Baroque to the 21st century
- Repertoire information
 - Full Title, Full Composer Name, and Estimated Timing
- A link to an Unlisted YouTube video playlist of the proposed repertoire for pre-screening
 - Single or multi-movement works are acceptable (if within the 10-minute limit)
 - Selections or excerpts from pieces are acceptable (if within the 10-minute limit)
 - When submitting your repertoire, please consider the appropriate musical moments to cut your piece(s) to ensure all selections fit within the time limit.
- Memorization is welcomed but not a requirement for pre-screening or during the Concert.
