

RESTORATION LAOS AND MAG ACHIEVEMENTS APRIL TO JUNE 2024



In April 2024, Restoration Laos began funding Mine Action Team 53 for the third year.

The team have deployed to Natangchai village, Boualapha district, Khammouane province.

Despite decades of peace, this province remains one of the most contaminated by unexploded bombs putting the lives and livelihoods of communities at risk.

Restoration Laos is helping to save lives and rebuild futures.



6,705 ITEMS

of scrap metal have been checked and removed. Every signal has to be explored by the team in case it is a deadly item. This is labour intensive but ensures every explosive item is found.

66,831 M²

of land cleared and released – 30% of the annual project target – for safe use. This is approximately 12 football fields of land. The team first use the large loop detectors to pick up signals which could be an unexploded bomb.
