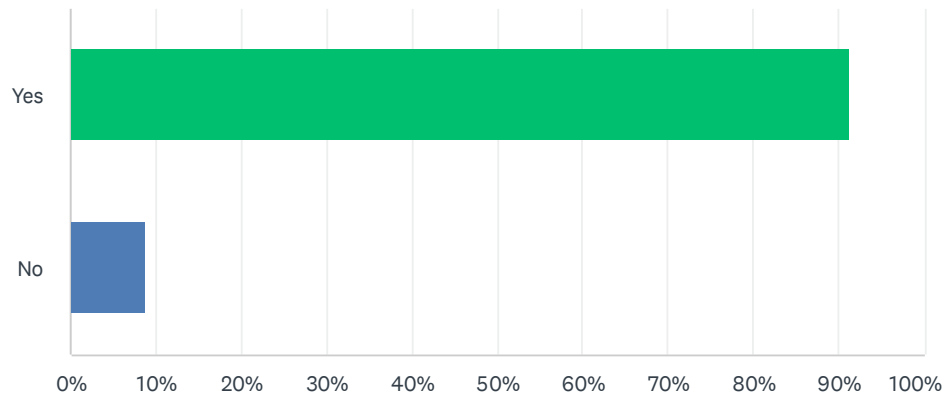


Q1 Did you know the clubs main aims are to support mens mental health?

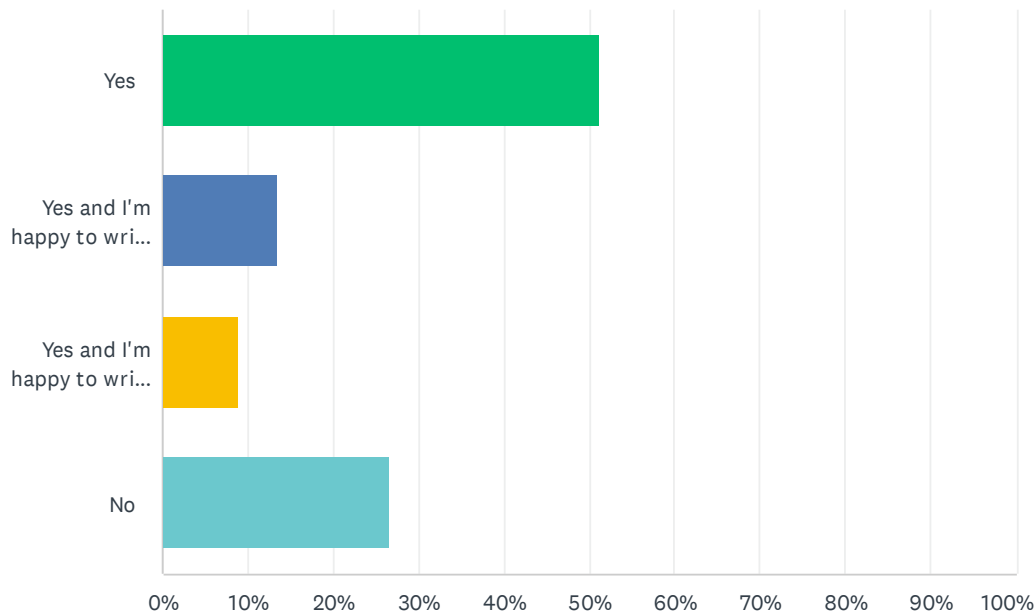

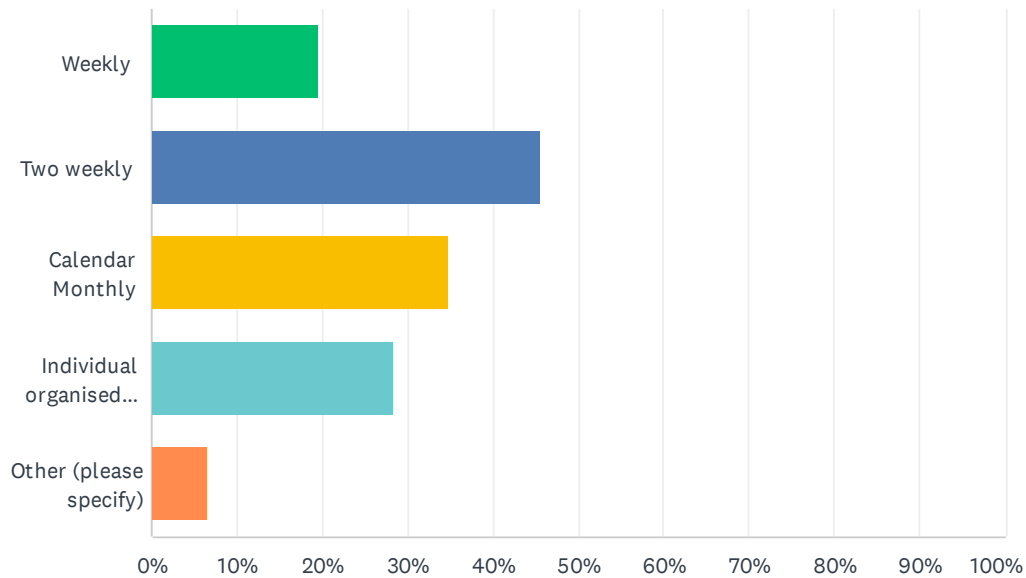

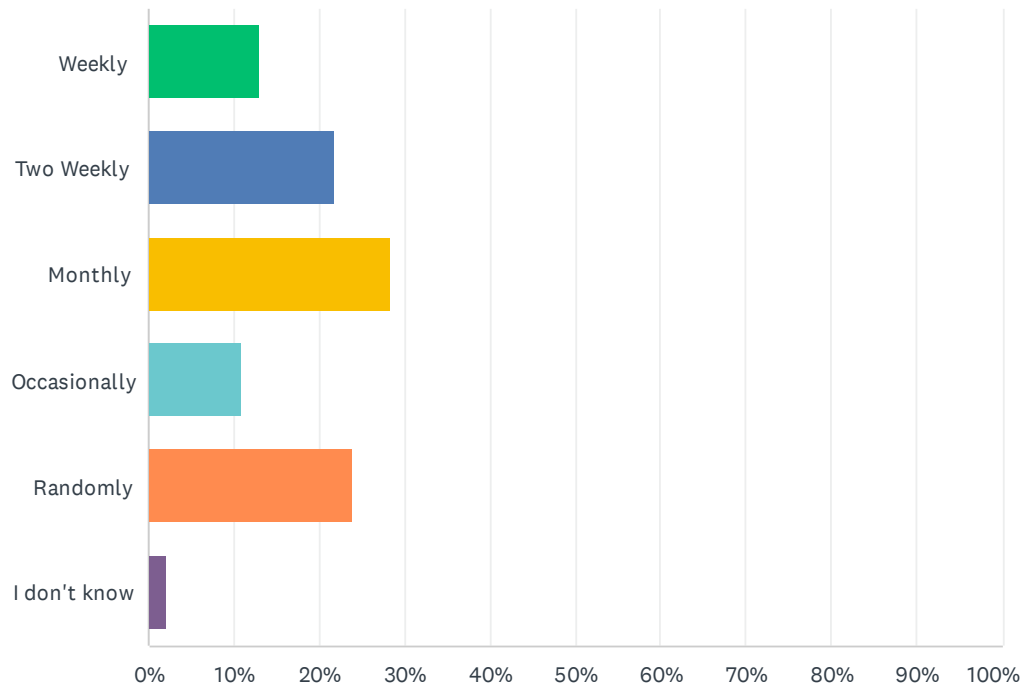

Q4 How often do you think you may attend?

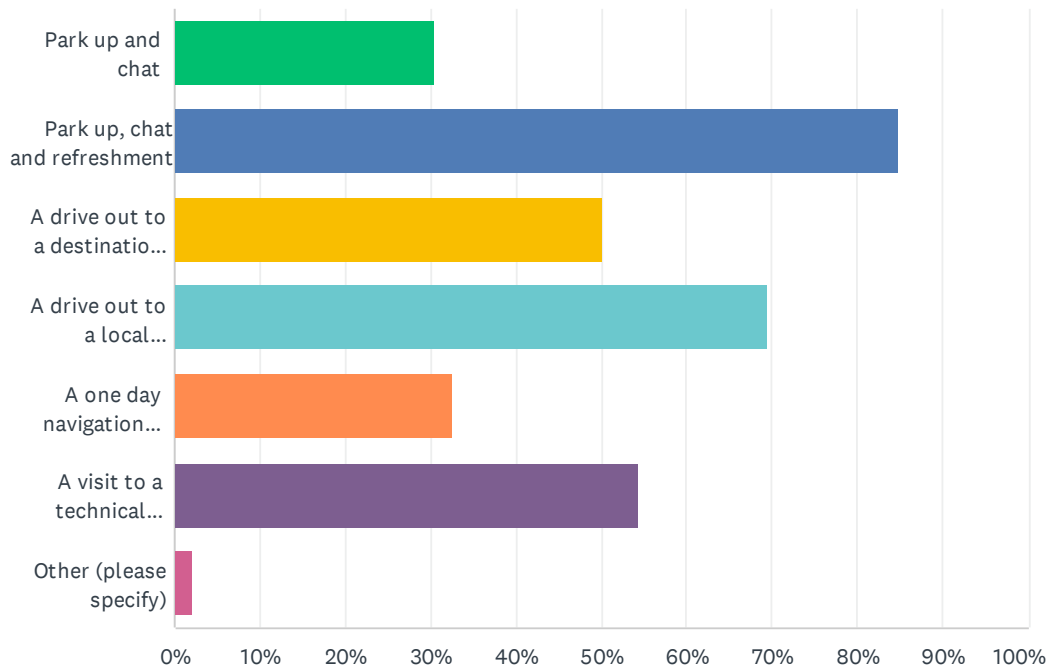

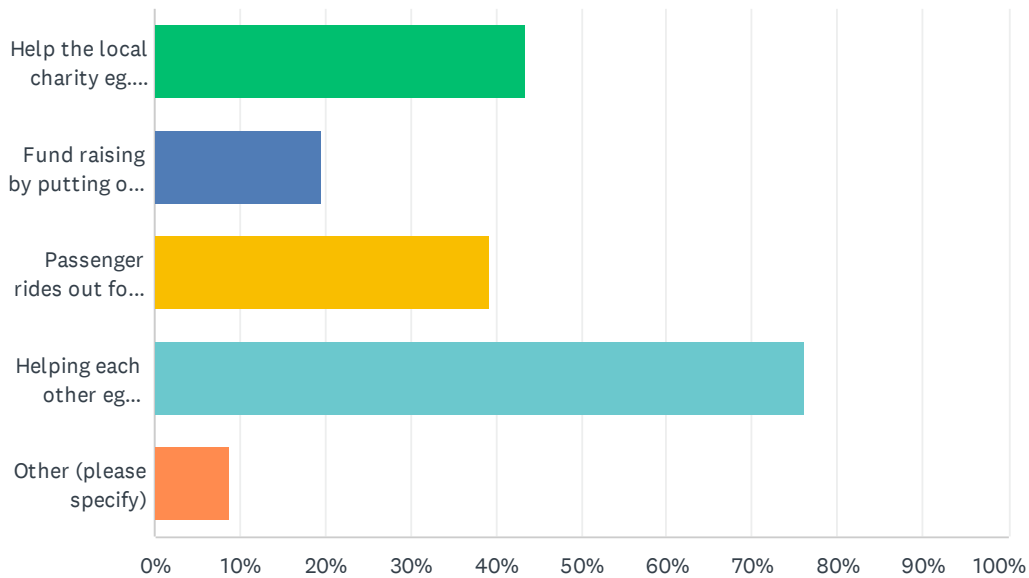

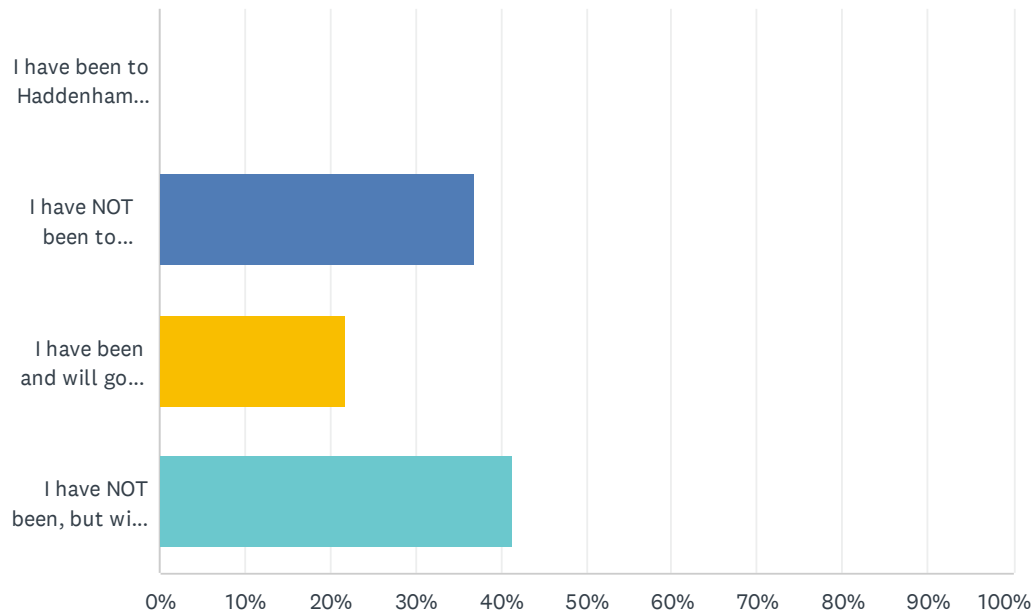

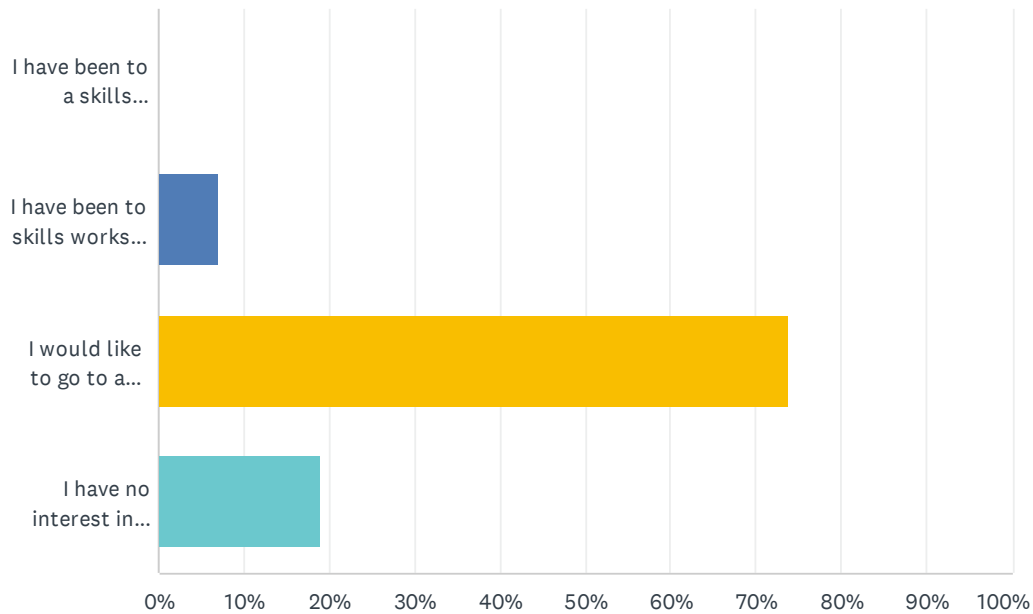

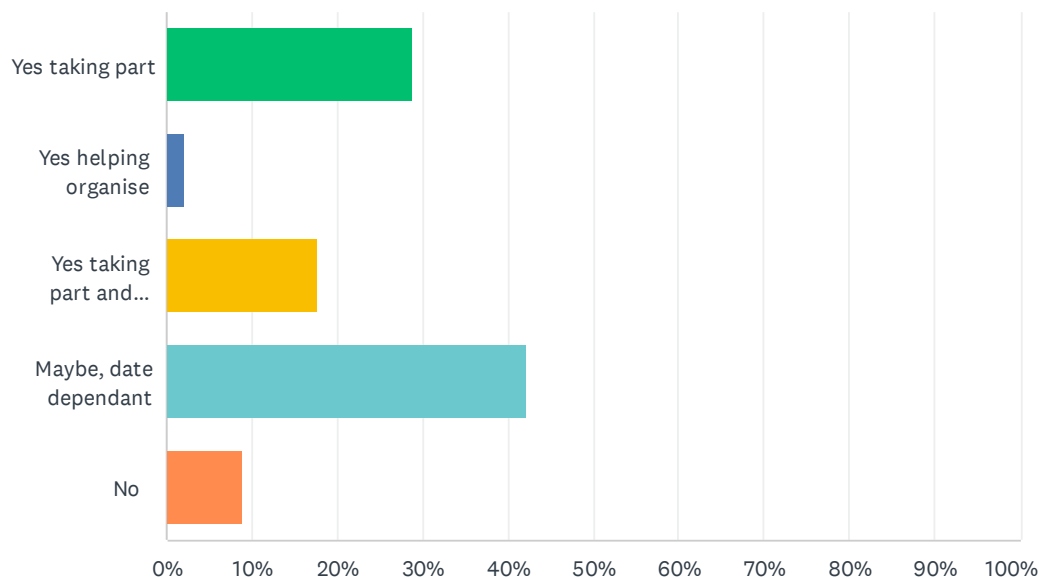

Q10 Club Cafe / Workshop Idea. We are currently looking for premises and funding for a club cafe and workshop, our own social space.

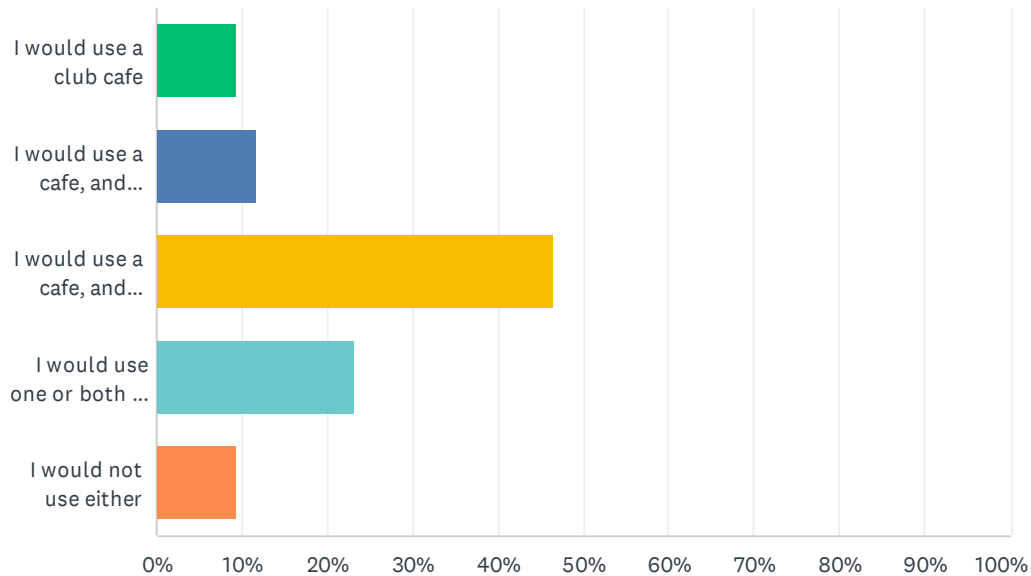

Q11 Club Cafe / Workshop Funding. This is a big step for the club and will need initial funding and be a viable business, so it needs to generate income.

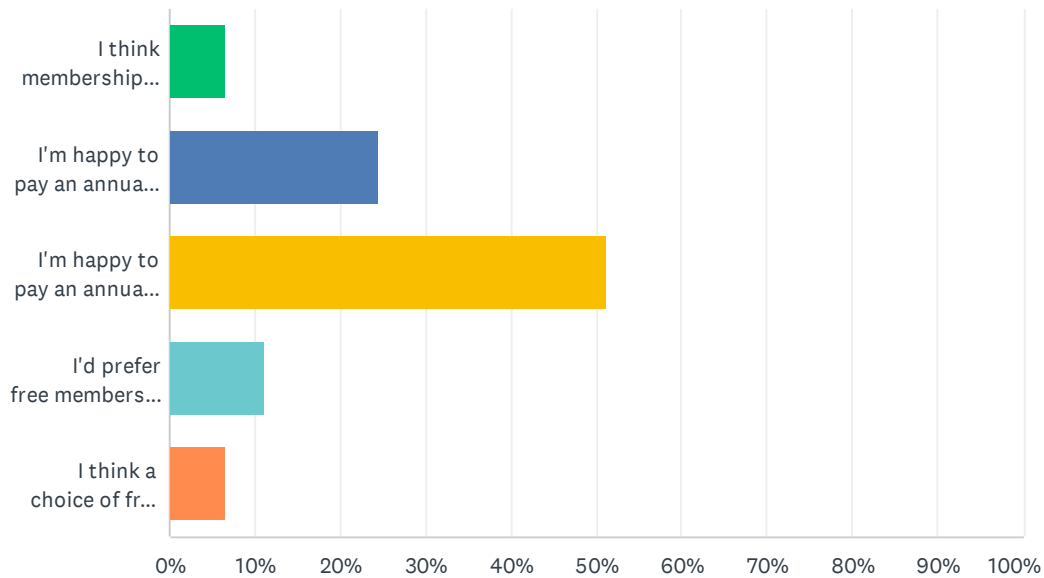
