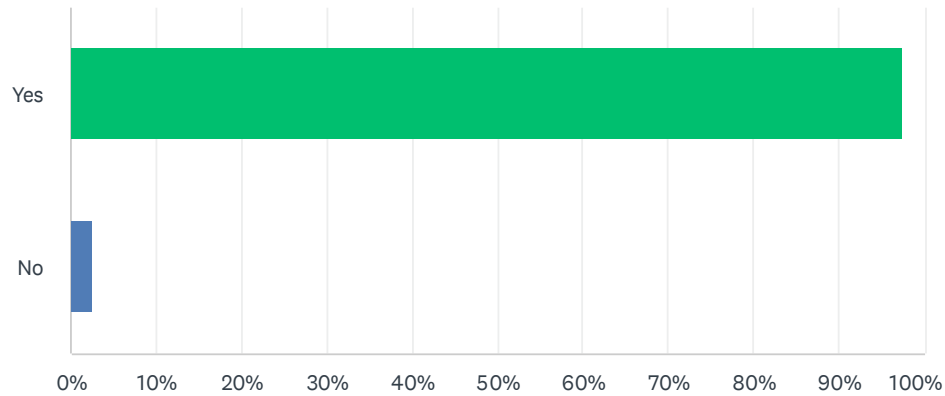


Q1 Did you know the clubs main aims, apart from being a motor vehicle club, are to support mens mental health by creating opportunities to socialise therefore reducing loneliness?

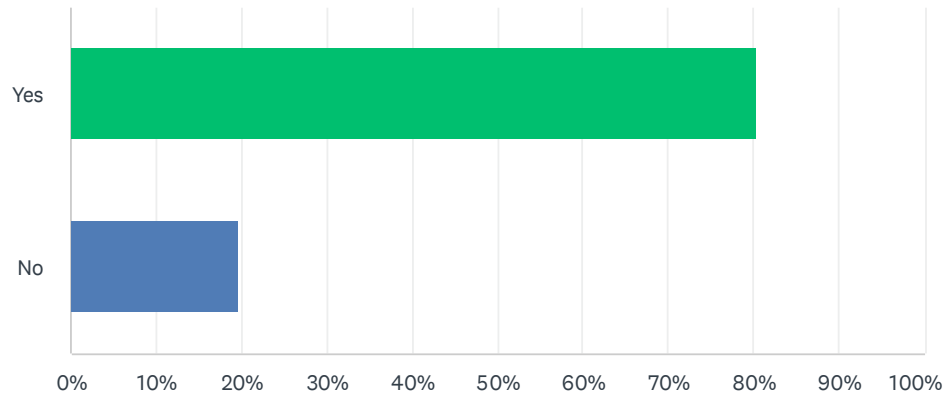

Q2 Do you think your mental health, outlook on life, has improved since joining the club? This could be as simple as having something to look forward to, people to talk to at meets and increased socialising.

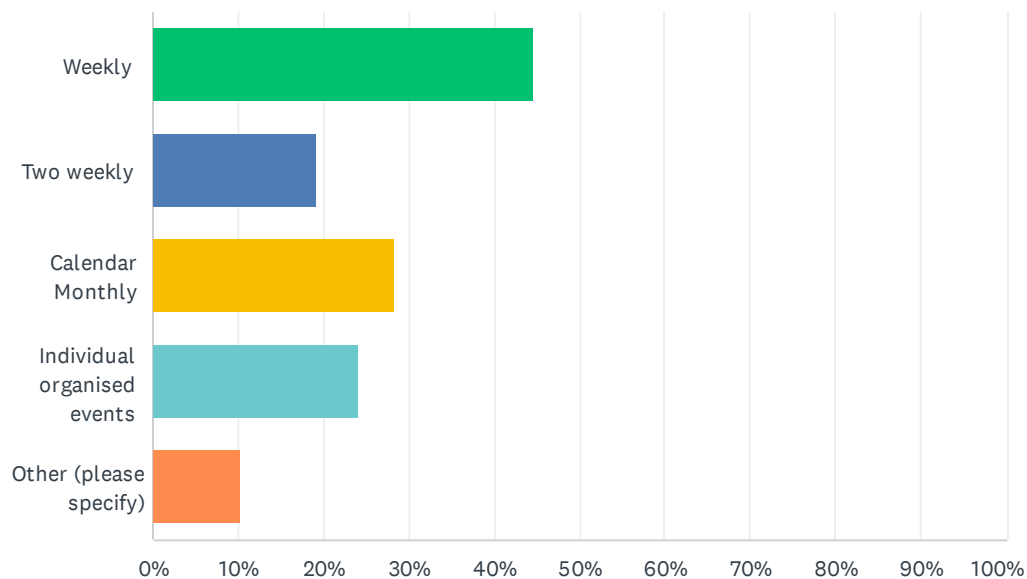

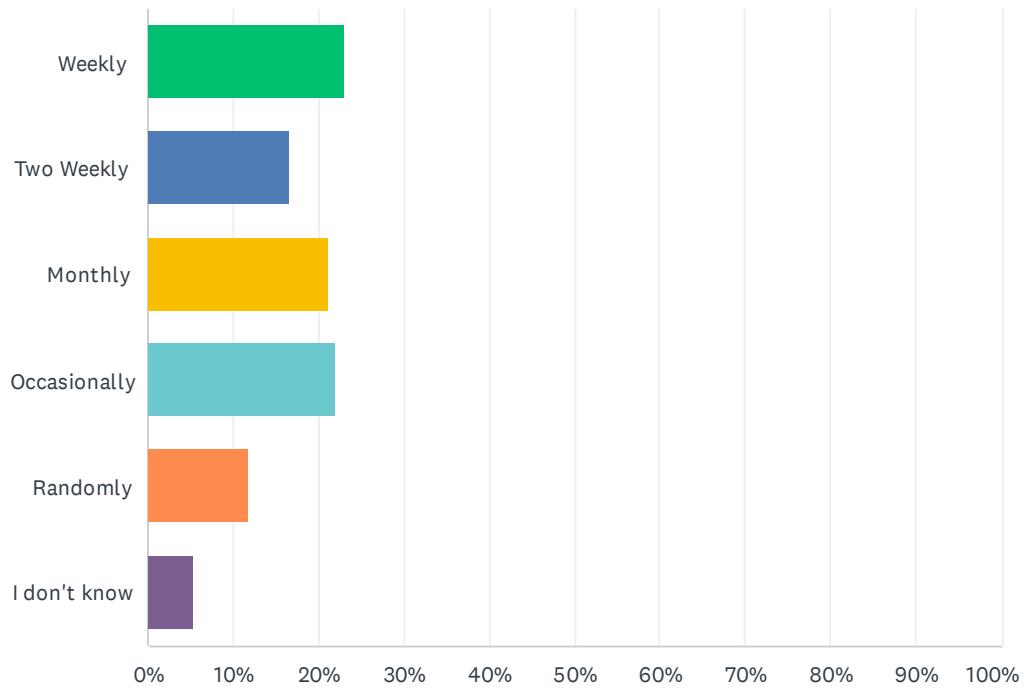

Q4 How often do you think you may attend?

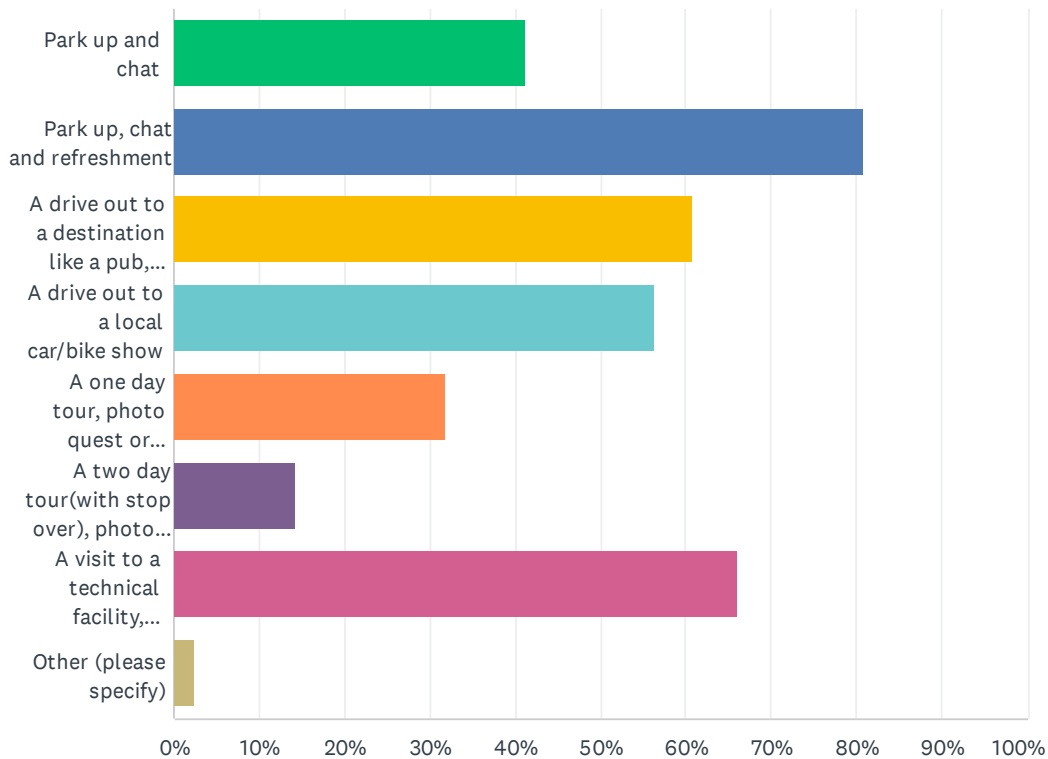

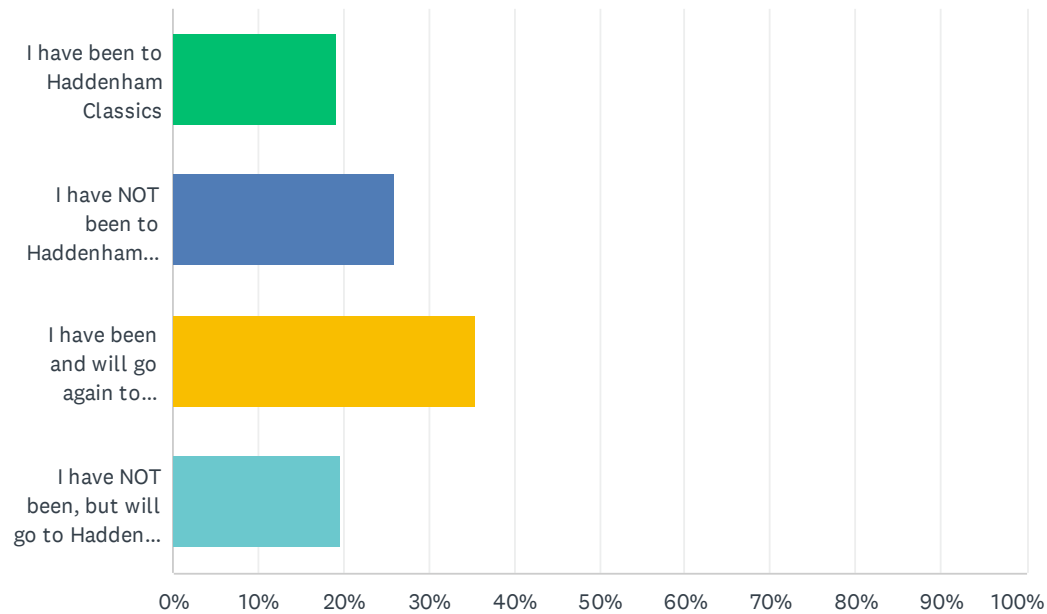

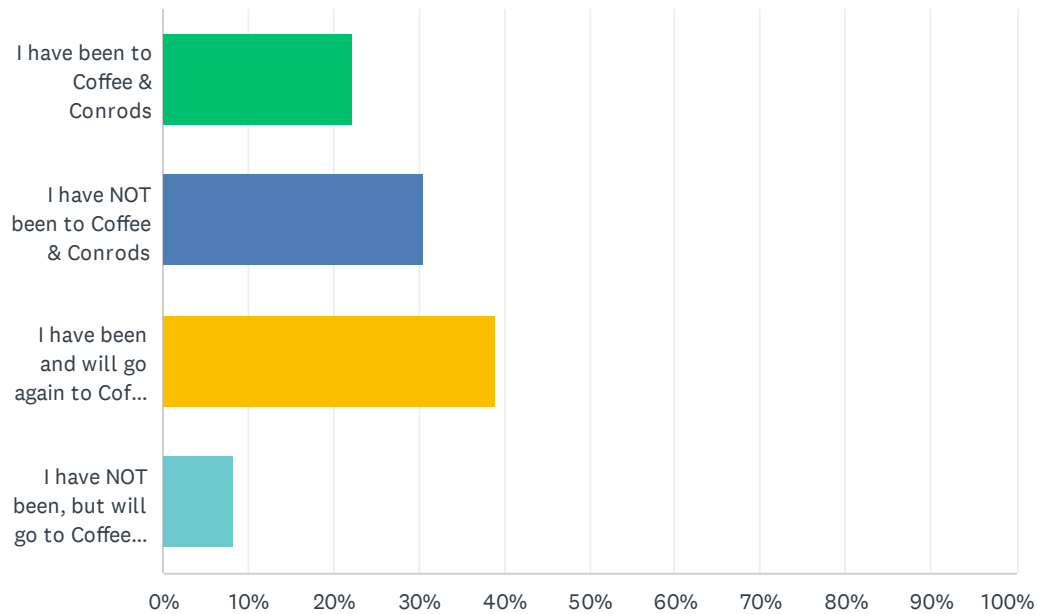

Q7 Coffee & Conrods is every Wednesday Morning

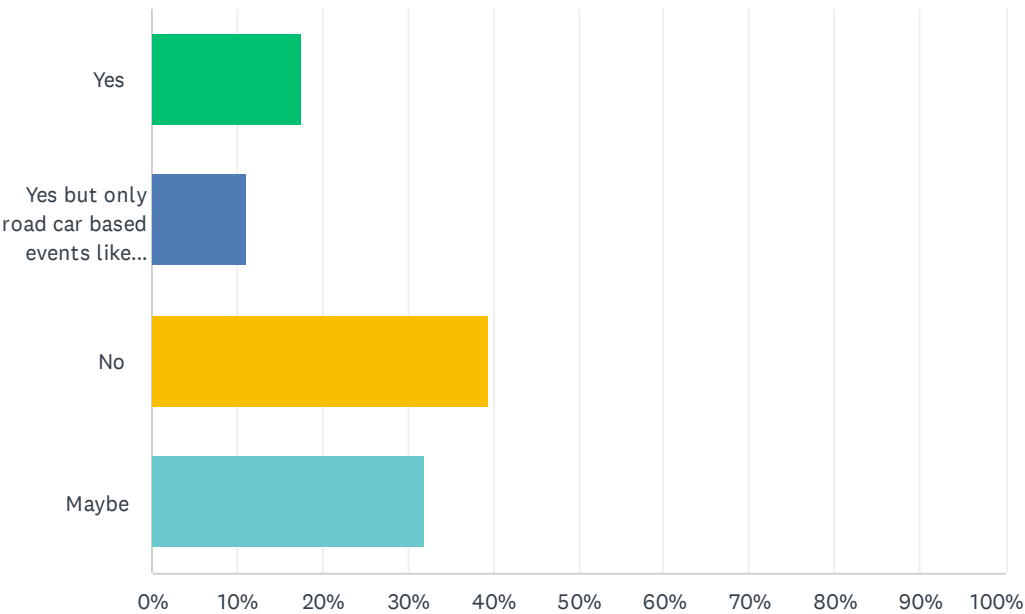

Q8 Would you be interested in taking part in competitive motoring events?

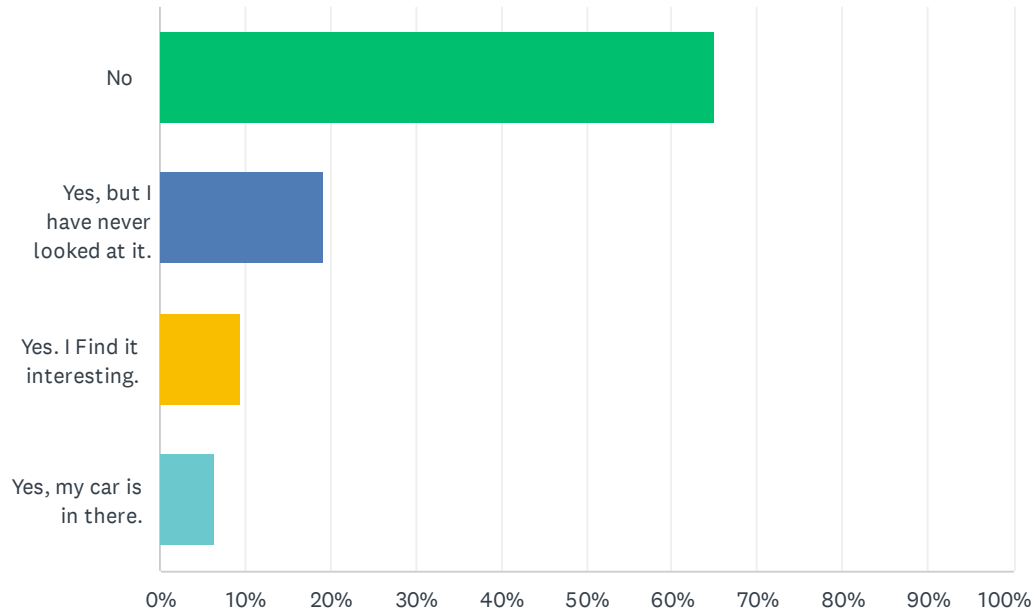

Q9 Did you know we list new members in the Members Zone if they supply a photo their vehicle?

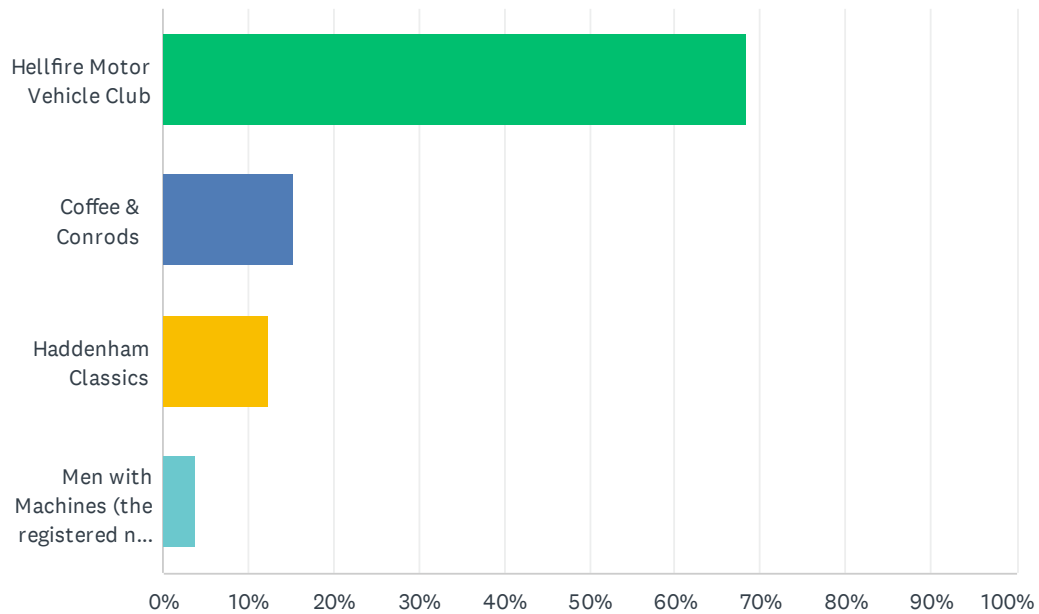

Q10 Which of the clubs brands do you associate most with?

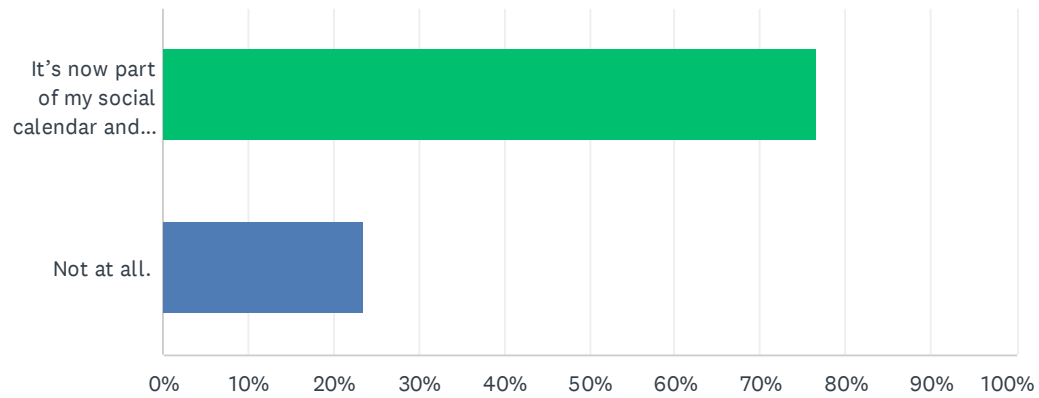

Q11 How attached are you to this brand?

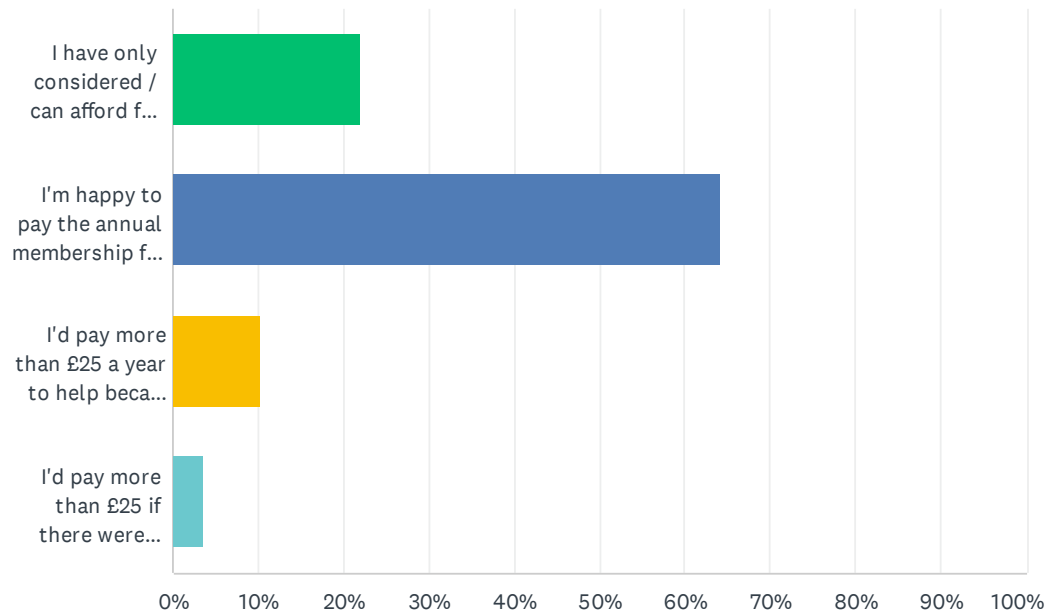
