
Parents of Marie Catherine Brown Frederick and Theresa Vicknair Brown, Jr.

FREDERICK BROWN, JR. was born August 29, 1872 in Head of Island, Louisiana, and died October 22, 1947 in Springfield, Louisiana. He was the son of Frederick Brown and Catherine Hermann. He married THERESA VICK-NAIR January 27, 1894, daughter of OSCAR VICKNAIR and CELESTINE LAMBERT. She was born January 22, 1876 and died April 13, 1975

Early ancestors of Frederick Brown, Jr. were:

Frederick Brown, Son of William Brown of London, England and Juanita Folles of Ireland, received permission to marry Marguerite Fauser, daughter of George Fauser of Wurttenberg, Germany and Dorothy Laubri of Mansfield, Germany.

Frederick and Marguerite Brown had the following children: Gertrude, Gregory, Joseph Antonio, Marguerite and Frederick II. Frederick cultivated 640 acres of land on the Amite River, St. Helena Parish, Section 46-8-4. He died in 1832, the year Livingston Parish was split from St. Helena Parish. His land was divided among his children.



Frederick II married Catherine Hermann and had the following children: Joseph, Amelia, Rosalie, Dorothy, Valsan, Frederick III, and twins, Adeline and Adele.

Frederick III married Eveline Delatte, daughter of Francois Luefrois Delatte and Marguerite Elmire Vickner. Frederick and Eveline lived at Head of Island. They had the following children: Vernnie, Frederick IV, Emma, Justine. The 1880 census has Frederick's mother Catherine along with a niece, Victoire Vickner living with


Note the tombstone at the cemetery in Springfield has Frederick Brown as a "Jr." He is actually the fourth Frederick Brown in this line.
