# **Springfield Schools**


Springfield, Louisiana is the oldest municipality in Livingston Parish. It is also believed to be one of the older settlements in the state. Springfield is situated on the west bank of the Natalbany River.

Due to its early establishment, Springfield was also the home of many of the first schools in the Parish. Children would travel to Springfield from other Parish towns to attend school.

All nine children of Edgar and Catherine Guitrau graduated from Springfield High School.

The two-story brick structure was constructed around 1925. The 1926-1927 school year was the first session as a high school. There were two members in the graduating class of 1927. They were Wall and Myrtle Anderson. When the school was built it was one of the most modern schools of its time. It had an auditorium, a large bell, and other "extras". Heat was provided by pot-bellied heaters. Mr. Vicknair, the janitor, cut wood for the heaters and built the fires. Unfortunately, the school fell victim to arson in 1971 and subsequently a new Springfield High School now stands on the same location.

In 1953, the elementary school was divided from the high school. The land on which the elementary school was built was purchased from Catherine Guitrau, wife of Edgar Paul Guitrau. Conveyance records show that 4.67 acres was bought by the school board in 1953 for the sum of \$5,500.00. The new elementary school opened in the fall of 1955. An additional 2.4 acres was sold by Catherine Guitrau in 1965 for \$ 3,600.00. Both of these tracks were adjacent to the Guitrau home on Blood River Road (LA 1037). Edgar and Catherine Guitrau had moved to Springfield around 1942 from Centerville (Springville). It is interesting to note in the sale of the land in 1965, the Guitraus' required



the school board to construct a chain link fence running the entire length of the property adjacent to the Guitrau property. This document was also witnessed by their son-in-law, Clarence Palmer. It is also interesting to note that the property, and the deed to the Guitrau home were held in Catherine Brown Guitrau's name. After research and inquiry by the author, the story is Edgar Guitrau involvement in politics, and often participation in tax sales, he wanted to protect his family by placing the legal title to the homesite in his wife's name instead of his own.



It was while stationed in California she met Clay Harrold. Clay is a retired Captain from the Navy.




They reside in Reno, Nevada and Palm Springs, California. Both enjoy traveling and the outdoors and often visit with family and friends across the United States with their travel trailer.









# Brother, Sister Unexpectedly Meet in Belgium

Staff Sgt. Edgar P. Guitreau, Jr. and Lt. Gentvieve Guitreau, ANC, are the son and daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Edgar P. Cuitreau of Springfield. Sgt. Guitreau entered the Army in October 1940 and has been overseas since January 1944. Lt. Guitreau entered the Army Nurses Corps December 1943 and was sent iverseas November 1944. The brother and sister hadn't seen each other for over three years until they met in Belgium Jan 13.

The following is a letter from both Sgt. and Lt. Guitreau to their parents, giving the details of their meeting in Belgium.

Germany, Feb. 13 Dear Mother and All.

Last month I met some nurses and after asking about Jimmie. it turned out that they knew her, and where she was. Well the next day I was on my way to see her. It so happened that the first hospital that I stopped she was there. I told the nurse that I was her brother and that I wanted to surprise her. When she saw me she nearly fainted. If you have a map of Luxumburg or Belgium look north east about 20 miles and you will find a town by the is located. I thought she could speak good French, although I had to do all the talking. bought something that I thought was hair tonic and after two or three applications I found out it was bath water. Well, you live and learn. We went to a cafe and had a couple of drinks and they are expensive- 50 FR. or the same thing as a dollar. Yes Jim- Dearest Mother, Dad and All,

mie had to pay for it because I didn't have much and I was having a big time watching her. She would give the cashier a 1,000 franc note (\$22.80) for a 10 cent article and he had given her only half of her change when she turned around and started to walk out. I had to tell her that there was more coming. Yes she was about to give the buy a \$19.90 tip. Did we langh. Well name of Arlan. That's where she it was pretty late and I had a long ways to go on slippery frozen roads so I left about five o'clock. She sure looks good except that she has lost lots of weight.






























# Services held for local resident
