- What is 4 Paws at the Fort?
4 Paws at the Fort is a fun dog show, with exhibitions, stalls and activities for all of our canine friends.
- Which dates is 4 Paws at the Fort?
Saturday 13th June and Sunday 14th June 2026
- What times does it run?
10:00 – 15:00 daily (last admission 14:00)
- What is the entry fee?
Bookable in advance £5.00 per adult (Early Bird) and £6.00 per adult (on the day). £2.50 per child (Early Bird) £3.00 per child (on the day). Family tickets are available.
Dogs go free!
Carers go free upon providing relevant carers pass.
- Is there parking?
There is limited parking available on site.
- Will there be competitions?
Yes these will be run online prior to the event and on the day. Presentations will be held at 12:00 and 14:00 on both dates.
- Is this event dog friendly?
Indeed it is, for the only dates of the year we allow dogs on our tours as well.
- Can I book a tour on the day?
We will be offering 50% off tunnel tours on these dates.
- How do I book a stall?
If you would like to book a stall please email admin@fortamherst.com and we can arrange a booking form to be sent to you.
- I am a stall holder, when can I set up and take down?
The site will be open from 0800 for stall holders, you should be ready for opening at 10:00 and close down starts no earlier than 15:00.
- I am a stall holder can I park next to my stall?
Whilst we try to ensure a space near to your car this is not always possible, however we will get you as close as we can.
- I am a stall holder can I stay overnight?
Yes you can, however this is at your own risk. We do have toilet facilities; however we do not have shower facilities and you will need to arrange your own food (no BBQs permitted onsite).

- I am a stall holder can I leave my stall overnight?
We do not recommend leaving any aspect of your stall overnight, whilst we attempt to secure your property, we are no way liable for your items and as an open site we do not recommend any items being left.
- How many stalls are you going to have?
It is hoped approximately 40 stalls on each day.
- How many visitors are you hoping to get each day?
We are hoping for more than 400 visitors per day, last year we had over 300 visitors per day.
We will be using social media, local advertising and radio to advertise the event.
- Where do the profits go?
10% of all ticket sales are donated to Dogs Trust. All other profits are donated to Fort Amherst Heritage Trust, to protect and improve Fort Amherst.
