DANIEL BOONE JUNIOR CHEER LEAGUE RULES & EXPECTATIONS

MEMBERSHIP:

- 1. Membership is open to K through 6th graders zoned for Gray, Ridgeview, Fall Branch, Sulphur Springs, Boones Creek schools and surrounding areas.
- 2. Participants must:
 - a. Be willing to follow the attendance policy below.
 - b. Be willing to put forth best effort to learn new skills
 - c. Be willing to be respectful at all times towards other squad member and coaches
- 3. All parents are expected to provide accurate contact information to allow open communication between the Daniel Boone cheer advisor, the squad coach or any other advisory board member who may need to have contact.
- 4. All participants and parents must agree, sign and adhere to the DBJR Cheer/ WJAL (Jr. Blazers)/BOONE BALLERZ code of conduct. All rules and expectations are available to view on dbjrcheerleague.com or a copy can be requested by sending an email to dbjrcheerleague@gmail.com.

SQUAD PLACEMENT:

- 1. Participants will be placed on squads according to grade level and/or school.
- 2. Squads will be determined based on number of participants
- 3. Squads will rotate games to ensure that each team is supported at least once throughout the season.
- 4. All cheer placements on squads are final for the season after the first week of practice.

ATTENDANCE POLICY:

- 1. Participants will be expected to attend practices as the coaches have scheduled unless sick or other circumstances prevent them from attending. If your child was absent from school for sickness, they should also not attend practice. If the cheerleader is unable to attend practice, they will not be allowed to participate during any new stunts or routines.
- 2. Parents are expected to communicate absences, late arrivals, or early pick-ups from practice or games with the coach.
- 3. Participants are expected to arrive at practice on time and at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled game time.
- 4. Failure to attend 75% of practices and games will result in consequences.

PRACTICES:

- 1. Parents are responsible for making arrangements for the child to be picked up at the end of each practice as well as communicating with the coach as to who may or may not pick up the child. If there is any legal documentation involved; the parent shall present those documents to the DBJR Cheer advisor.
- 2. Practices are closed to parents, exceptions will be made for any special circumstance presented to the coach.
- 3. Participants are expected to wear appropriate attire (cartwheel short/legging and a t-shirt) and sneaker style shoes with hair fixed out of their face and no jewelry.

- 4. Participants should come to practice prepared and ready to learn. Each coach will inform participants and parents of their individual expectations for the season.
- 5. Practice times and locations will be determined by the coach after each season begins. Practice locations shall be scheduled in a community-based location.
- 6. Coaches are not allowed to schedule practices on days that Washington County Schools are not in session for scheduled breaks. If Washington County Schools are closed or closes early for inclement weather practices will also be canceled.

GAMES:

- 1. Coaches are responsible for providing the game schedule once a schedule is released by the DBJR board.
- 2. Participants are expected to arrive at scheduled games 30 minutes prior to the game.
- 3. Participants are expected to arrive in full uniform "hair bow, top, skirt, bloomers, socks, and white cheer shoes, with both pom poms".
- 4. Participants should secure their hair in a manner that does not distract them throughout the game.
- 5. Each participant shall bring a water bottle to have on the sidelines.
- 6. Participants should attempt to use the bathroom prior to the game to prevent interruption during the game.
- 7. Participants are expected to follow the instructions of their coach and participate in cheers and chants.
- 8. Each squad is allowed to perform at half-time.
- 9. Game admission for the season is \$3.00 for parents, grandparents and students (Cash Only). Kids are free. Cheerleaders and players in uniform may enter for free.

EXPECTED BEHAVIOR:

- 1. Parents are expected to maintain professional conduct on social media platforms at all times, especially when discussing the cheerleading program, coaches, fellow parents, or other athletes.
- 2. Participants and Parents are expected to be respectful to the coach and all league members at all times. Any concerns or conflict shall be presented to the coach first and if not resolved presented to Daniel Boone Jr. Cheer board through email (dbjrcheerleague@gmail.com).
- 3. Profane, obscene, or rude language will not be tolerated by any participant or parent at any time.
- 4. Participants and parents are expected to show good sportsmanship to all other participants and parents at all times and be supportive to others at all times.

CONSEQUENCES:

- 1. Verbal warning from the cheerleader's coach
- 2. Written warning from DBJR Cheer Board
- 3. Suspension from practice and/or games
- 4. Removal from the team
