MELISSA LAWTON is the Assistant Director of Willow Rock Crisis Stabilization Unit, the Alameda County WIC 5585.50 receiving center for adolescents ages 12 to 17 on a civil commitment hold. As the Assistant Director and a former clinician at this center, she has personally completed over 500 risk assessments and continues to provide clinical supervision to crisis clinicians. Through this work and curiosity, she has learned much about suicide assessment, and she continues to learn more as she engages with other providers and organizations in the Bay Area. She is also an adjunct instructor for San Francisco State University's Graduate Clinical Mental Health and Marriage and Family Therapy programs.

This training is designed to help participants become familiar with the idea, statistics and prevention techniques of suicidal ideation. Participants will discuss the problem of youth suicide and learn how to recognize of the signs of suicidal ideation and techniques to help prevent suicide. This training focuses on active listening and responding to client's questions related to suicide.
