Recognize, Intervene, Support, Empower

The Supportive Families, Safe Homes training for parents and community members uses activities and discussion to build foundational knowledge around healthy child development and the experiences of LGBTQ children and youth. Participants develop deeper levels of empathy and increase skills in supporting any LGBTQ or gender variant children or youth who may be placed with them.

Maria Ramirez has spent over 20 years providing direct services to children and families in crisis with Uplift Family Services, formerly known as EMQ FamiliesFirst in Campbell, CA. She is currently a Senior Learning Partner and has worked in the Foster Care and Adoptions Services Program and Addiction Prevention Services. Maria supports the development and delivery of trainings to resource/foster parent as well as professionals working with children and families.

Maria is a certified facilitator of the Therapeutic Crisis Intervention training for professionals (TCI), family caregivers (TCIF) and for schools (TCIS). She is also certified in Family Wellness, Positive Discipline, Mental Health First Aid for Youth and is a CPR/First Aid Instructor.
