

Diagnosis and Treatment of Substance Use Disorders

JENNIFER BAITY, LCSW, LAADC is a licensed clinical social worker and licensed advanced alcohol and drug counselor. She is the Program Director at the Mental Health Rehabilitation Center at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital. She provides staff and intern supervision and training; provides individual, group, and family treatment for adults with serious and persistent mental illness who also have problematic substance use histories; and co-developed the co-occurring disorders (dual diagnosis) program at the San Francisco Behavioral Health Center. She has provided in-depth training to clinicians providing services to youth and adults since 1991 and regularly trains staff in mental health and substance abuse programs throughout the San Francisco Bay Area and beyond. She specializes in training on diagnosis and treatment of individuals with co-occurring mental health and substance use conditions and motivational interviewing.

This 2-day, 15-hour, in-depth pre-licensure class on the assessment and treatment of substance-related disorders was developed for ASWs, AMFTs, and APCCs and meets BBS criteria (although CEUs are not currently available for this training). It is also appropriate for any other staff members who want simply to learn more about this issue. Topics covered include: commonly used drugs and their effects, current drug use trends, screening and assessment, warning signs, an overview of substance-related disorders as defined in the DSM-5, treatment strategies such as relapse prevention, harm reduction, and motivational interviewing, dual diagnosis/co-occurring disorders, ways for family members to receive help and for them to assist their loved ones who need care, referral information and more. Attendees should leave this training with a solid basic understanding of how to recognize and treat people with substance-related problems and how to differentiate them from people who use drugs without significant problems.
