Cornell University model for Therapeutic Crisis Intervention is taught to clinical staff as a resource for working with children and families. Days 1, 2, and 3 of the 4-day course are designed to guide staff in implementing alternatives to physical restraints when caring for a child in crisis. Day 4 of this course is available only to authorized personnel and is designed to guide staff in safely implementing physical restraints when necessary for a child in crisis. A TCI certified instructor facilitates this lesson with the aid of video, role-play, and group discussion.
