- Learn several techniques to monitor and work at regulating breathing
- Explore gentle movement, stretching and yoga exercises to allow the release of tension in the body, both on the floor and seated in a chair
- Experience guided visualizations to promote relaxation and focus, and reduce symptoms of stress
- Consider the best practices for applying these gentle exercises in a variety of contexts
