Managing client medications represents an area of great responsibility for STRTP/Residential staff. If medication is not properly handled and monitored, it may actually place a client at great risk for negative outcomes. This training will explain how the administration of medication is allowed only by trained staff, and how to offer assistance and observe the taking of medication to ensure proper administration. (This includes topical medications, psychotropic medications, liquids and ointments.) Attendees will learn the standards of maintaining a complete record of medication history and how medications are always locked and secured per CCL regulations. This comprehensive training will greatly increase your knowledge of the importance of your role in medication administration, and the understanding that with your assistance, our clients will have a better quality of life. Topics of discussion will include: medication orders, CCL mandated documentation procedures and forms, JV-220/JV-223 court ordered processes surrounding psychotropic medication, proper handling and disposal of medications for juveniles as well as non-minor dependents (NMD's).
