#### We Now See that God's Kingdom has a SON (KING)

Why are the nations restless And the peoples plotting in vain? The kings of the earth take their stand And the rulers conspire together <u>Against the LORD</u> and against <u>His Anointed</u>, saying, "Let's tear their shackles apart And throw their ropes away from us!" <u>He who sits in the heavens laughs</u>, <u>The Lord scoffs at</u> <u>them</u>. Then <u>He will speak to them in His anger And terrify them in His fury</u>, saying, "But as for Me, <u>I have installed My King Upon Zion</u>, <u>My holy</u> <u>mountain</u>." (Psa. 2:1-6) NASB

Only ask, and I will give you the nations as your inheritance, the whole earth as your possession. You will break them with an iron rod and smash them like clay pots." Now then, you kings, act wisely! Be warned, you rulers of the earth! Serve the LORD with reverent fear, and rejoice with trembling. Submit to God's royal son, or he will become angry, and you will be destroyed in the midst of all your activities for his anger flares up in an instant. But what joy for all who take refuge in him! (Psa. 2:8-12) NLT

I say, "<u>Keep the command of the king because of the oath before God</u>. "<u>Do not be in a hurry to leave him</u>. <u>Do not join in an evil matter</u>, for <u>he will do whatever he pleases</u>." Since the word of the king is authoritative, who will say to him, "What are you doing?" One who keeps a royal command experiences no trouble, for a wise heart knows the proper time and procedure. For there is a proper time and procedure for every delight, though a person's trouble is heavy upon him. (Eccl. 8:2-6) NASB

Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. To draw near to listen is better than to offer the sacrifice of fools, for they do not know that they are doing evil. Be not rash with your mouth, nor let your heart be hasty to utter a word before God, for God is in heaven and you are on earth. Therefore let your words be few. For a dream comes with much business, and a fool's voice with many words. When you vow a vow to God, do not delay paying it, for he has no pleasure in fools. Pay what you vow. It is better that you should not vow than that you should vow and not pay. Let not your mouth lead you into sin, and do not say before the messenger that it was a mistake. Why should God be angry at your voice and destroy the work of your hands? For when dreams increase and words grow many, there is vanity; but God is the one you must fear. (Eccl. 5:1-7) ESVS

Therefore **let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken**, and thus **let us offer to God acceptable worship**, **with reverence and awe**, for **our God is a consuming fire**. (Heb. 12:28,29) ESVS

Let us <u>hear the conclusion of the whole matter</u>: <u>Fear God</u>, and <u>keep his</u> <u>commandments</u>: for <u>this is the whole duty of man</u>. (Eccl. 12:13)

The <u>fear of man bringeth a snare</u>: but <u>whoso putteth his trust in the LORD</u> <u>shall be safe</u>. (Prov. 29:25)

And **do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul**. **Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell**. (Matt. 10:28) ESVS

And He summoned the crowd together with His disciples, and said to them, "<u>If anyone wants to come after Me</u>, <u>he must deny himself</u>, <u>take up his cross</u>, <u>and follow Me</u>. (Mark 8:34) NASB

## What <u>KINGDOM</u> do You Belong To?

## Most People Don't Understand What it Means to be in The KINGDOM

They relate it to their church, a denomination, a set of moral rules and regulations, or some type of Historical Dogma etc... To be in God's Kingdom means; you belong to it's KING (Jesus Christ). He Lives in you by the Holy Spirit, and you live to do His will.

The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit." (John 3:8) ESVS

What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. (1 Cor. 6:19,20)

In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you. But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. (John 14:20,26) ESVS

#### Kingdom Authority in the Name of Jesus

"<u>Any place that does not receive you or listen to you</u>, as you go out from there, shake the dust off the soles of your feet as a testimony against them." (Mark 6:11) NASB

"The one who hears you hears me, and the one who rejects you rejects me, and the one who rejects me rejects him who sent me." The seventy-two returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!" And he said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven." (Luke 10:16-20) ESVS
