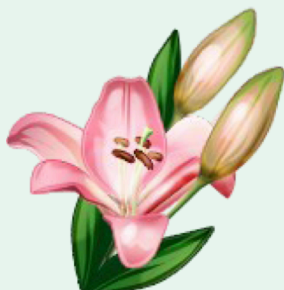


Give Thanks for Loved Ones and Say Amen to Flowers!
