The 2024 Black Forest Festival will be held on **Saturday, August 10th**. This year marks the 55th year that the Black Forest community will be able to come together and celebrate all that makes our community so wonderful. The festival theme this year is, **“55 Years of Tradition”**. For 55 years, the BF Community Club’s dedicated sponsorship, alongside local church, business, and volunteer support, has succeeded in bringing the Black Forest community together for a family-friendly, fun day.

The festival aims to celebrate life in the forest and is an opportunity to highlight aspects which we hope to preserve and propagate for generations to come. You can expect this year’s festival to be a great time with neighbors far and wide. The festival weekend also

Note from Mack Sharp about the Line Dance Class:

On 19 Jun 2023, the Black Forest Community Center's Line Dance Class, headed by founder, Mack Sharp was honored to have a couple of international celebrities as part of it. These celebrities are none other than Mr. Scott Moore, 21-time national Pickleball champion and his very talented wife. Mr. Moore was recently inducted in the Hall of Fame. During the 1 1/2 hour class, Mr and Mrs Moore were welcomed by our Dancers and learned fun dances, such as "Makes Me Shiver", "Cold Heart" and "Wild Wild West" to name just a few. Due to a serious knee issue, Mack was unable to instruct on this date, however, his wife, a seasoned and talented Dance Instructor taught and lead all the dances beautifully and the entire class of approximately 30 laughed and had a wonderful time according to those present. The Black Forest Community and Center are indeed honored to have such distinguished guests in our community and our center and we're glad the Sharp couple were there to make them feel welcome and part of our community through dance lessons.

Mack Sharp has been an active member of our community for 20 years now and has served in various positions, including as a Director, Vice President and most recently, as President of our club. He founded this Line Dance Class nearly 6 years ago and has

raised nearly \$10,000 all of which was donated to our community center. When Mack formed the Dance Class he almost immediately filed with the United States Patent and Trademark Office to have his dance Group called the "Black Forest Line Dancers". As a last year, this trademark name was verified by the USPTO.
