- 🏉 Be attentive in coaching sessions
- 🏉 Do not swear or be abusive during games or coaching sessions
- 🏉 Recognise and appreciate the efforts made by coaches, match officials, parents and administrators in providing the opportunity to play at the club and enjoy the rugby environment
- 🏉 Respect the facilities offered by Gosforth Rugby, the Club House and its environment.
