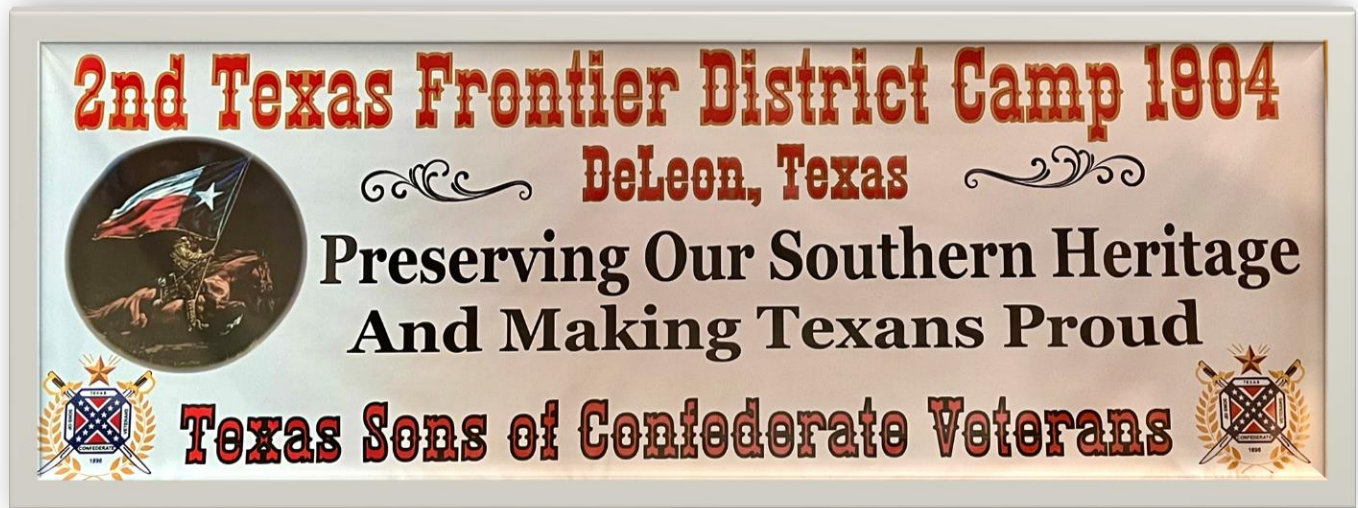

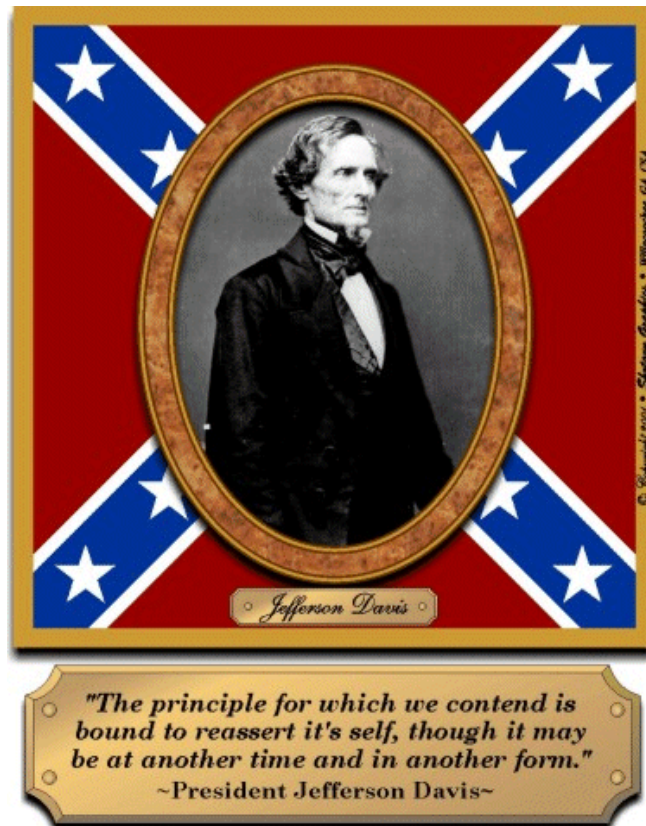

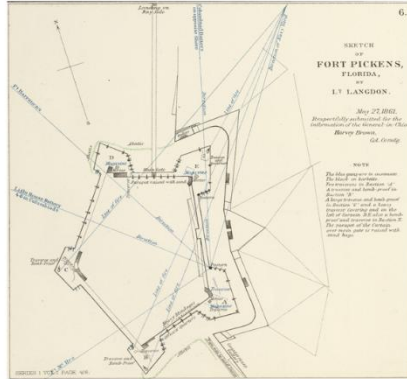

 - 2. Rowan Expedition, also heading for Charleston;
- FT Pickens
 - 3. Captain Adams' ships, lurking off Santa Rosa Island;
 - 4. Colonel Brown's Expedition, heading for Pensacola; and
 - 5. Porter's Expedition, also steaming for Pensacola - more to come on this expedition

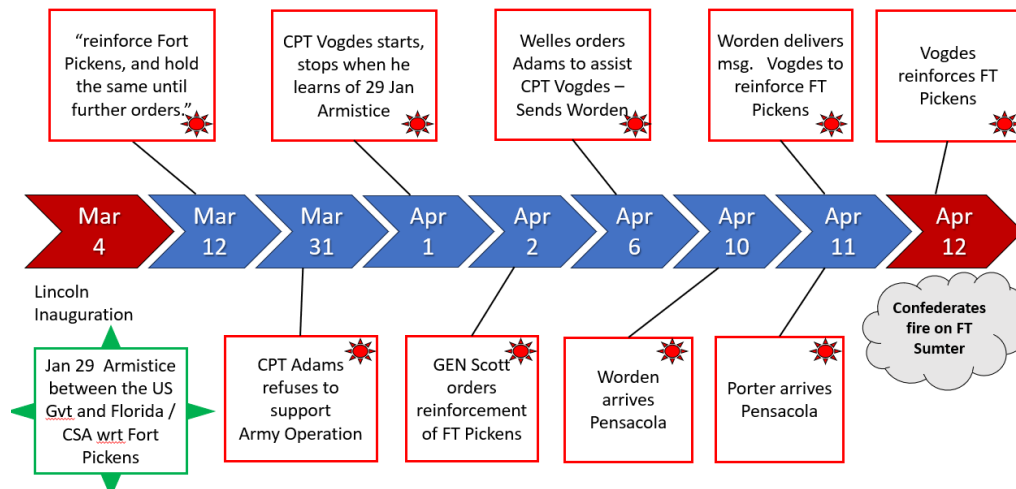


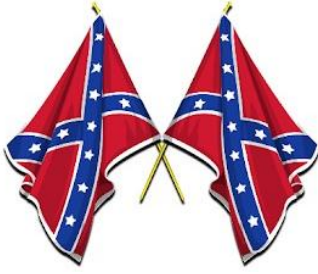
