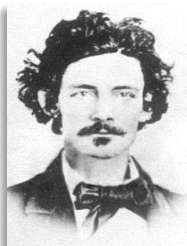
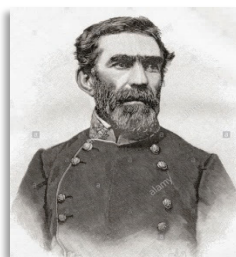
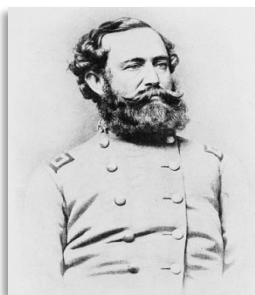
MARCH 4, 1862 ~ BATTLE OF PEA RIDGE

#### WADE HAMPTON III

Born March 28, 1818 SC

Died April 11, 1902 SC

Governor, Senator, "God of War".

Twenty thousand mourners followed his casket to Trinity Churchyard in Columbia. Wade Hampton's final words were, "God bless all my people, black and white."

#### BRAXTON BRAGG

Born March 22, 1817 NC

Died September 27, 1876 TX

Buried Magnolia Cemetery

Mobile AL General Braxton

Bragg's triumph at the Battle of Chickamauga was the most significant Confederate victory in the Western Theater.

#### HIRAM B. GRANBURY

Born March 1, 1831 MS

Died November 30, 1864 TN

He commanded the 7<sup>th</sup> Texas, CSA.

The City of Granbury, TX, is named in his honor. He Served as Chief justice of McLennan County, attorney and Mason. He was killed in the Battle of Franklin TN.

#### PATRICK CLEBURNE

Born March 16, 1828 Ireland

Died November 30, 1864 TN

Killed in the Battle of Franklin TN

*"If this Confederacy, that is so dear to my heart, is doomed to fail, I pray heaven may let me fall with it, while my face is toward the enemy and my arm battling for that which I know to be right." The "Stonewall of the West".*

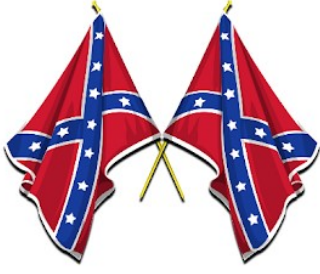
