





#### **Direct Loan Program**

Owner-occupants of 1-4 unit residential buildings are eligible for a \$20,000 loan at 3% interest for the cost of eligible repairs with a 5-15 year repayment period.

#### **Handicap Accessibility Program**

Owner-occupants who own a 1-4 unit residential building are eligible for a \$20,000 deferred loan at 0% in order to make any unit in their home handicap accessible.

#### Elderly Deferred (62 years or older)

Owner-occupants age 62 or older who own a single family home are eligible for a deferred \$20,000 loan at 0% interest for the cost of eligible repairs.

North Shore Road (Route IA) over the Saugus River (General Edwards Drawbridge).

Bridge Maintenance and Median Barrier Replacement Underway.

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing that it has commenced the installation of a fixed work zone on North Shore Road (Route 1A) in Revere and Lynn, across the General Edwards Drawbridge.

This work zone will allow contractors to complete repairs to address structural deterioration at one location beneath the bridge median and to replace the existing, deteriorated concrete median barrier across the bridge with a temporary steel barrier. The fixed work zone will remain in place until construction activities are complete, which is expected in fall 2025.

Traffic will be affected as follows:

Route 1A northbound is reduced from two lanes to one lane and will remain in that condition on a continual 24/7 basis, beginning in the area near the Lynnway on-ramp in Revere, across the General Edwards Drawbridge, and ending in the area near Hanson Street in Lynn until the overall repair work is fully complete.

• Route 1A southbound will be temporarily reduced from two lanes to one lane across the bridge during overnight hours on Sunday through Thursday evenings from 8:30 p.m. each evening to 5:00 a.m. the following morning to complete the replacement of the median barrier. Once the median barrier replacement work is complete, the contractor will complete the targeted bridge repairs working within the fixed, work zone during daytime hours, Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and two lanes will be available on Route 1A southbound.

Appropriate signage and law enforcement details will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

Drivers traveling through the area should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.



#### MASSDOT ADVISORY

Overnight Lane Closures and Detours on Route 129 (Lynnfield Street)

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing temporary overnight lane closures on Route 129 (Lynnfield Street) between Lookout Terrace and Lebel Road. These lane closures are scheduled to occur weekly, Monday

These lane closures are scheduled to occur weekly, Monday through Thursday nights, from 9pm-5am the following morning, beginning Monday night, August 25, and continuing through Friday morning, September 19, to allow crews to safely and effectively perform pavement milling, resurfacing and other items of work.

Lane closures will be required with varying traffic management plans. Detours may be utilized depending on the operation and specific location within the limits of work.



Estos cierres de carriles están programados para ocurrir semanalmente, de lunes a jueves por la noche, desde las 9:00 p.m. a 5:00 a.m. de la mañana siguiente, comenzando el lunes 25 de agosto y continuando hasta el viernes 19 de septiembre por la mañana, para permitir que el personal de mantenimiento realice trabajos de molido de pavimento, repavimentación y otros trabajos con seguridad y eficacia.

Se requerirán cierre de carriles con diferentes planes de gestión del tráfico. Se podrán utilizar desvíos según la operación y la ubicación específica, dentro de los límites de trabajo. Este trabajo se está realizando en el marco de un proyecto de permiso de acceso a la carretera estatal.
