The Kenilworth Sailing Club is pleased to offer the Sailing Camp to participants entering 6th through 9th grades. This program offers a fun environment for those who want to learn how to sail. The camp is supervised by our experienced staff.

The Program:

The Water Sports Camp will be offered in three sessions:

- **Monday, June 10 through Friday, June 21 (weekdays only) 1 pm to 4 pm**
- **Monday, July 15 through Friday, July 19 9:30 am to 12 pm**
- **Monday, August 5 through Friday, August 9 9:30 am to 12 pm**

We will take up to 16 students in each class. Enrollment will be on a first come basis. There will be a make up day on the Monday's following each session if needed due to poor weather conditions.

The Curriculum:

The Water Sports Camp will be what your children remember most about growing up near the lake. They will like it because it is all about enjoying the lake with friends. Parents like it because it is safe, supervised, and in the neighborhood! The camp focuses on enjoying three water sports: Kayaking, Paddleboarding and Sailing. Daily activities will depend on the weather and the water. At different times during the camp, there will be relays, races and games. KSC staff will review launching and boarding, returning to the beach and disembarking, boarding from the water, and maneuvering. Water safety will be emphasized at the beginning of each session.

Safety:

Trained KSC Staff are on duty at all times to assist in the launch and return of boats, and retrieval by boat rescue, if necessary. Every participant must have his/her own US Coast Guard approved vest-type life jacket on the first day of instruction, and must wear the jacket at all times on the water.

Special Features of the KSC Program:

Sailboats, kayaks and paddleboards are provided at no additional cost for the exclusive use of the Water Sports Camp during class periods.

Eligibility and Requirements:

The program is open to non-club members and to residents of the Sears School District, as well as to Kenilworth Sailing Club members and residents who are entering grades six through nine. A simple swimming test of 50 yards in lake waters is given during the first week of the program. Shoes (tennis or water) must be worn at all times, and warm clothing, such as a windbreaker and sweatshirt, should be brought each day.
