We Are All Sinners

Romans 3:10 — As it is written: There is none righteous, no, not one.

Romans 3:23 — For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Every human being has sinned. No one can meet God's perfect standard on their own. This reveals our universal need for a Savior.

↑ The Consequence of Sin

Romans 6:23 — For the <u>wages of sin is death</u>, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Sin earns a penalty—spiritual death. Humanity cannot escape this consequence without God's intervention.

ff God's Gift to Us

Romans 6:23 — For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

God offers eternal life as a gift—freely given, never earned. Salvation is offered to all through Jesus.

God Demonstrates His Love

Romans 5:8 — But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Jesus died for us at our worst. God's love came before we ever reached for Him—this is grace in action.

[†] The Way to Salvation

Romans 10:9 — If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Salvation comes through believing in Jesus Christ and confessing Him as Lord. It is a personal decision of faith.



God's Promise to All

Romans 10:13 — For whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

God's promise is inclusive—available to anyone, anywhere, who calls upon Jesus.



New Life in Christ

Romans 8:1 — There is therefore <u>now no condemnation</u> to those who are in Christ Jesus. Romans 8:38–39 — ...nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Through salvation, we receive forgiveness, freedom from condemnation, and the assurance that nothing can separate us from God's love.
