- Try to come early to accommodate parking.
- Plan to enter the Drive-In Worship via Fremont Ave/Cty. Rd. 4 and exit from the East [Fellowship Hall] side of the building.
- We love you and want to see you, but please, if you have any COVID-19 symptoms (cough, fever, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, etc.) join us for worship online via our Facebook Page: [St. John Facebook Page](#)
- Sound will be completely controllable by you! We will broadcast via your FM radio in your vehicle. Tune to FM 105.7 in the parking lot.

- We will have a no-contact offering option, but we encourage everyone to please consider electronic giving.
- It is wonderful to see everyone...and so tempting to get out of our cars to say “hi”, but we Lutherans know how to avoid temptation, so we will stay in our vehicles.

- We will celebrate Holy Communion in our vehicles. [It is a *safe* bet that Luther never could have imagined it, even though he was a forward-thinking guy!]
- It is Kick Off Sunday too, so plan to wear your favorite team's colors, just for fun.
- If you have Sunday School age kids, we encourage you to go to the web-site and register for *Takin it Home Sunday School*. Not only does this register you for Sunday School, it assures that we have the correct information to keep in touch with you during COVID19.

Update on in-sanctuary Worship Services

“It is not as simple as unlocking the doors and letting people back into the building.”

St. John has a safety task force in place to work on the steps to move us back to in-person worship as soon as we can safely do so. We have several guidelines to follow and benchmarks to meet before we return to in-person worship safely. With an uptick in the # of cases in our immediate area, we will not be returning to the Sanctuary in September. We will reevaluate the situation in 30 days. Online worship continues every Sunday. 
