Induction into the NKJF HOF is considered a great honor. It is the HOF's obligation to only consider members with exceptional background, skills and reputation so that the honor of induction is not diminished. Therefore, the Committee will not induct a member into the Hall of Fame simply because they have been a member for a long time and meet the minimum rank and age requirements. The committee must find all minimum requirements are met but also find there is something exceptional about the candidate. The committee can consider the number of different styles they are ranked in, the number of students or dojos they run, their high position in groups or associations, tournament or fighting achievements (personal or that of their students) if appropriate – and of course perhaps the most important is their own martial arts skill. Books, publications, videos and magazine articles can all help a nominee. None of the aforementioned items for consideration are necessary, just possible areas that may elevate the candidate.

Please do not nominate someone for induction into the NKJF Hall of Fame unless they fulfill all the minimum qualifications and if you can document why this person is in the very top tier of martial artists. If you are not confident that your nominee will be considered, we encourage you to consider one of the many Awards offered by the National Karate Jujitsu Hall of Fame.

### **HOF inductees must:**

- be a current NKJF member in good standing.
- be nominated by a fellow NKJF member or directly by the HOF Committee.
- demonstrate good character and dedication to the Marital Arts.
- meet all documented minimum requirements.
- receive a unanimous decision by all voting members of the HOF Committee.

### **Minimum Requirements**

- 50+ years of age
- Roku-dan 6<sup>th</sup> Dan or higher
- Continuous marital arts training/teaching for at least 25 years
- Currently or previously the head Sensei of his or her own dojo
- Have an exceptional reputation inside and outside of the martial arts
- Served in a leadership role within a martial arts organization, preferably NKJF

Please provide all the necessary information for your nominee to be considered for induction into the National Karate Jujitsu Hall of Fame. Complete all areas of the form and provide any support documentation necessary. Email completed nomination forms to info@ishibei.org.

If selected, their name and/or photo will appear on the NKJF-USA website and on social media. They will also receive a beautiful 11x17 certificate suitable for framing.
