

A Case Study of the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency

Enhancing Public Safety through Grant Administration

Challenge

The Temple, a progressive house of worship and school in Brooklyn, New York, faced persistent concerns about potential anti-Semitic threats. With a history of anti-Semitic incidents in the region, the Temple recognized the need to enhance their security infrastructure and preparedness to mitigate the risk of terrorist attempts. However, they lacked the financial resources and expertise to implement comprehensive security measures.

Solution

To overcome this challenge, the PCCD collaborated with EMD, an external consulting firm, and a confidential Pennsylvania Police Department. Together, they worked on the application process for the Crime Reduction Project grant. Ms. Mula from EMD led the coordination efforts, ensuring all necessary documents and application information were prepared and submitted. The partnership leveraged the expertise of EMD and the resources of the PCCD to develop a strong grant proposal.

Result

The collaborative efforts resulted in the successful acquisition of \$258,733.00 through the Crime Reduction Project grant. This funding will be used to purchase new radio communications equipment for the Pennsylvania Police Department, including portable radios, mobile radios, base stations, vehicle repeater systems, and necessary accessories. The equipment will comply with interoperable approved P25 standards, promoting seamless communication among law enforcement personnel.
