Airports

Bangor Airport (BGR) offers direct flight options and is about an hour's drive from the island. Car rentals are convenient and more widely available compared to Bar Harbor Airport.

Bar Harbor Airport (BHB), located just outside Mount Desert Island (MDI), is much closer. It offers direct flights from select airports in New England. However, if you're traveling from outside the New England area, you'll need to take a connecting flight through a major city to reach Bar Harbor. Keep this in mind, especially when traveling with your new pup!

Puppy Friendly Activities

Acadian Boat Cruise downeastwindjammer.com: Looking for a water adventure with your pup? Acadian Nature Cruises welcomes leashed dogs aboard their two-hour narrated cruise of Frenchman Bay. You'll spot seals, eagles, and stunning coastal scenery while enjoying a dog-friendly crew that often has treats and blankets ready.

Scenic Drive through Acadia: Want a more laid-back tour of the park? Try a drive down Park Loop Road, a 25-30 minute cruise down the park's most scenic road. There are plenty of spots to take a stop along with way for pictures or a quick puppy potty-break.
