***Be careful whenever layering or combining glazes, sometimes normally stable, stiff glazes can create a eutectic in combination and be quite fluid. ~Cara ***Aventurine and Seaweed are both runny alone, many more are runny in combination with other glazes. Even if you use two non-runny glazes they may run when layered. Oatmeal, Blue Rutile, Palladium, Textured Turquoise, Ancient Jasper, and many others

***Some of the glazes also will run if you have more than the recommended amount -- 4 coats of Ancient Jasper, it will definitely run if applied very heavily. Another option is to create a tiny ledge at or near the foot that will slow down the flow of glaze. Even just a sharp change of angle can slow the glaze, which can be enough to slow or slop glaze runs. ~Cara
