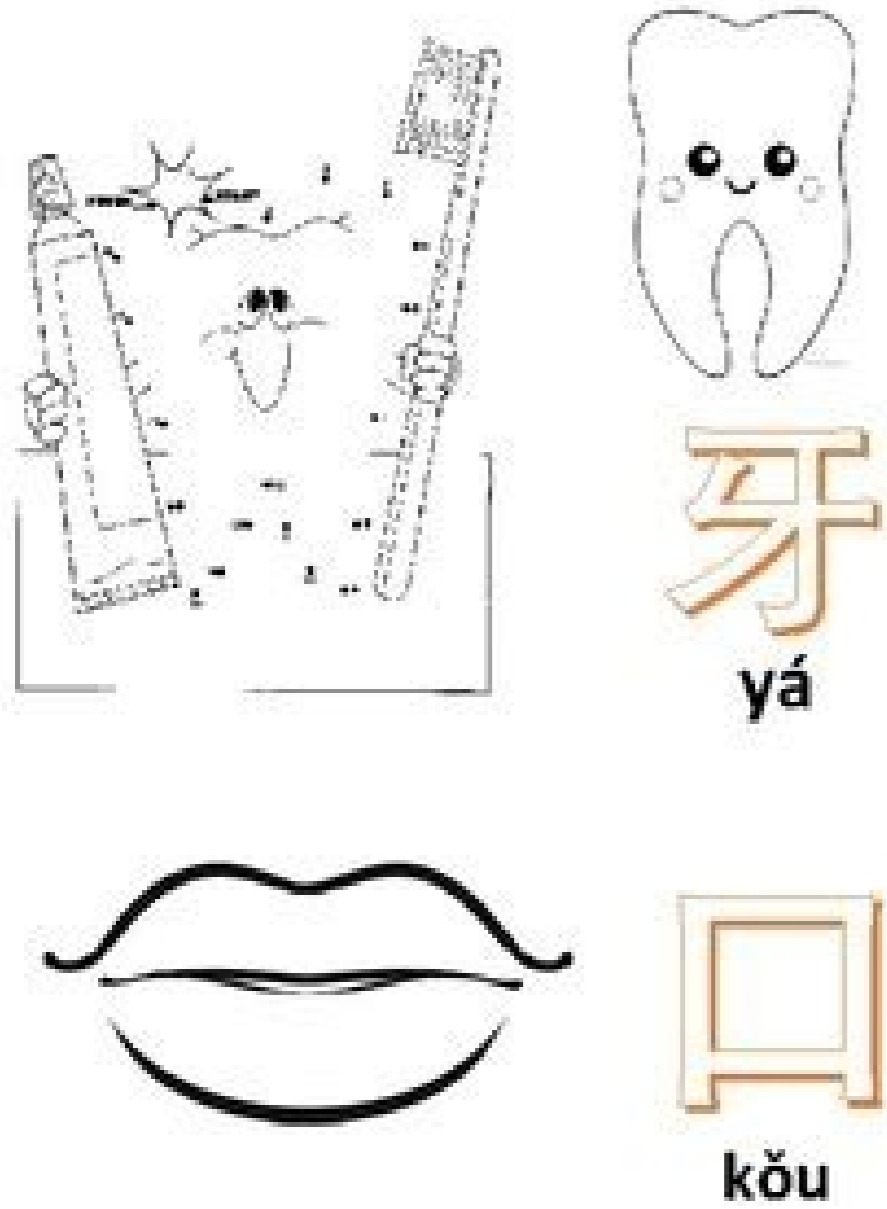

So with that being said, let's learn how to talk about body parts in Chinese. Let's make a few example sentences using these words for you also: Your muscles are very big你的肌肉很大 Nǐ de jīròu hěn dà You have beautiful hair你的头发很漂亮Nǐ de tóufǎ hěn piàoliang My body is much stronger these days这些天的身体更强壮 Zhèxiē tiān wǒ de shēntǐ gèng qiángzhuàng Body Parts in Chinese – Head and face – 头脸 (tóuliǎn) Let's start with the top. Here is some useful vocabulary for talking about the head and the face... When applying these words be sure to check out our post on basic grammar structures in Chinese so you can apply the adjective to the body part correctly 头 tóu – head脸 liǎn – face眼睛 yǎnjīng – eye鼻子 bǐzǐ – nose鼻孔 bǐkǒng – nostrils 耳朵 ěrduǒ – ear嘴 zuǐ – mouth牙齿 yǎchǐ – tooth/teeth舌 shé – tongue脸颊 liǎnjiǎ – cheek额头 é'tóu – forehead眉毛 méimáo – eyebrows眼皮 yǎnpí – eyelid睫毛 jiémáo – eyelashes唇 chún – lips下巴 xiàba – chin舌 shé – tongue Here are some example sentences for you with some of those facial features. Body Parts in Chinese – Upper Body 上半身 (shàngbānshēn) Now let's talk about the upper body parts in Chinese, here below you'll find a list of words that compose the trunk. Now for some potentially useful sentences involving those body parts in Chinese! My back hurts We have 4 fingers and 1 thumb on each hand我们每只手上有4个手指和1个拇指Wǒmen měi zhǐ shǒu shàng yǒu 4 ge shǒuzhǐ hé 1 ge mǔzhǐ After exercising, my chest is getting bigger运动后我的胸部越来越大 Yùndòng hòu wǒ de xiōngbù yuè lái yuè dà Body Parts in Chinese – Hands 手 (shǒu) Hands play an important function in body language and sign language, so let's be more specific and learn this wordlist of the parts of a hand: Keeping in theme, let's add some context to these words by adding in some sentences you might find useful: My fingernails are so long我的指甲好长 Wǒ de zhǐjiǎ hǎo zhǎng Using your middle finger is rude用中指是不礼貌的 Yòng zhōngzhǐ shì bù lǐmào de Why is the ring not on your ring finger?为什么无名指上没有戒指? Wèishéme wú míngzhǐ shàng méiyǒu jièzhǐ? Chinese grammar is NOT as hard as you think. In fact it's a lot easier than many other languages. Here we introduce some key points and show you the way. Body Parts in Chinese – Internal organs – 脏腑 (zàngfǔ) Imagine seeing a doctor in China and not knowing the words of the internal organs. Not so easy to get your point across without the usage of body language! The list of vocabulary below might come handy in these kind of situations: 脑 (nǎo) – brain心 xīn – heart肝 (gān) – liver肺 (fèi) – lungs胃 (wèi) – stomach大肠 (dà cháng) – large intestine小肠 (xiǎo cháng) – small intestine 胆 (dǎn) – gallbladder膀胱 (pángguāng) – bladder尿道 (niàodào) – urethra脾 (pí) – spleen生殖器 (shēngzhìqì) – reproductive organs ... and some sentences with those words in action Sentence in EnglishSentence in PinyinSentence in HanziMy stomach is in a lot of painWǒ de dǔzi hěn tòng我的肚子很痛 Smoking is bad for your lungsKǐyān duì nǐ de fèi yǒuhài吸烟对您的肺有害 My nan has heart problemsWǒ nǎinai yǒu xīnzàng wèntí我奶奶有心脏病问题 Body Parts in Mandarin – Bladder Body Parts in Mandarin – Lungs Thinking of coming to learn Chinese?
