RECHARGE YOURSELF SPIRITUALLY, SO YOU WILL NOT BECOME A SPIRITUAL CASUALTY

As Christians and workers in God's vineyard, we must continually recharge ourselves spiritually so that we do not become weary or casualties in the spiritual battle. We cannot continually pour into others without allowing God to replenish us. Jesus reminds us, "Abide in me for without me ye can do nothing" (**John 15:4-5**).

Our strength comes from remaining connected to Christ through prayer, the Word, worship, and fellowship with the Holy Spirit. "They that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength" (**Isaiah 40:31**).

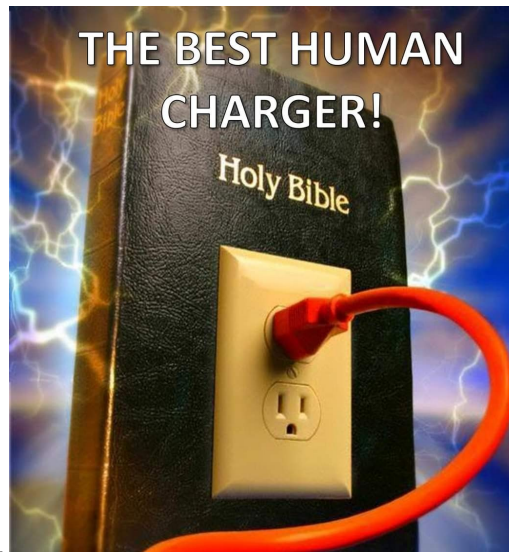
Spiritual exhaustion can happen even to faithful and anointed believers. Elijah experienced great victory on Mount Carmel yet afterward became discouraged and exhausted (**1 Kings 18-19**).

Therefore, we must guard our spiritual

lives carefully. "Let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall"

(**1 Corinthians 10:12**).

We must never become so busy working for God that we neglect our relationship



with God. Jesus Himself withdrew to pray (Luke 5:16), and He told His disciples, "Come ye yourselves apart, and rest a while" (**Mark 6:31**).

Prayer, Scripture, worship, spiritual fellowship, and appropriate rest help keep our spiritual fire burning.

God's vineyard needs spiritually strong and faithful laborers. Jesus said, "The harvest truly is plenteous, but the laborers are few" (**Matthew 9:37**). Therefore, we must protect our spiritual strength because there is still much Kingdom work to be done. We cannot depend only on yesterday's prayer, yesterday's revelation, or yesterday's anointing. We need a fresh

encounter with God continually. Paul encouraged Timothy, "Stir up the gift of God, which is in thee" (**2 Timothy 1:6**).

When our prayer life becomes weak, we must recharge; when discouragement comes, recharge; when ministry becomes merely routine, recharge; and when our spiritual fire begins to diminish, recharge.

We must also remember that working for God can never replace walking with God. Martha was busy serving, but Mary chose to sit at the feet of Jesus and hear His Word (**Luke 10:38-42**). In the same way, we must not become so occupied with church programs, ministry responsibilities, counseling others, preaching, teaching, or serving that we neglect our personal altar. "The fire shall ever be burning upon the altar; it shall never go out" (**Leviticus 6:13**). Our private relationship with God is what sustains our public ministry. The stronger our personal altar

Abide with Me

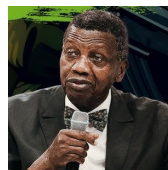
Abide with me: fast falls the eventide;
